#### What the Bible Says About Divorce (Part 3, conclusion)

taken lightly. As we reflect on Jesus' teaching in Matthew 5:31-32, we are reminded that marriage is a sacred covenant, designed by God to reflect His unending love and faithfulness to us.

#### **Divorce is a Last Resort**

Marriage is a union meant to last through the trials and joys of life; a bond that represents God's commitment to His people. Divorce, while permissible in extreme cases such as unfaithfulness or abandonment, is not God's ideal. It is a last resort; a path that should only be taken when every effort toward reconciliation has been exhausted. In a world that often treats marriage as disposable, we must approach this covenant with the seriousness and reverence it deserves.

I want to offer a challenge for those facing difficulties in their marriages: fight for your marriage. Remember the vows you made before God and each other - promises not just for the easy and joyful times but also for the challenging and painful seasons. These vows were spoken with a commitment to love, honor, and cherish, even when circumstances seem insurmountable. Standing firm in your commitment means trusting the Lord to work in your marriage, even when it feels like all hope is lost. God is the ultimate restorer, and He has the power to heal broken hearts and mend fractured relationships. Fighting for your marriage requires courage, perseverance, and a reliance on God's strength to move forward.

The second step is to seek God's guidance. Prayer is an essential tool in navigating the challenges of marriage. Couples should pray together, asking God for wisdom, direction, and softened hearts. Prayer invites God into the relationship, allowing Him to work in ways beyond human understanding. Additionally, studying God's Word together can provide clarity and strength. The Bible is filled with promises and principles about marriage that can encourage and guide couples in their journey. Finding Scriptures that speak to the sanctity of marriage and holding onto those promises can serve as an anchor during turbulent times. God's Word is not just a source of knowledge; it is a source of power, offering hope and renewal for those who seek Him

Finally, embrace His grace. Grace is the cornerstone of any healthy and thriving marriage, for it mirrors the grace that God continually extends to us. Never tell your spouse you have no more grace to give because God has never said that to you. His mercies are new every morning, and He calls us to extend the same forgiveness and compassion to others,

ivorce is never an easy decision, nor should it be especially our spouse. Forgiveness is essential to healing and reconciliation. It requires letting go of past hurts and allowing God to bring peace to your heart. This doesn't mean ignoring the pain or pretending that nothing happened; instead, it means choosing to move forward with love and patience, trusting God to redeem what feels broken. By extending grace to your spouse, you allow God's love to flow through you, creating an atmosphere of healing and hope.

> Divorce may sometimes seem like the easiest way out of a painful situation, but it is rarely the best solution. Marriage requires intentionality, perseverance, and a reliance on God's strength. When couples fight for their marriage, seek God's guidance, and embrace His grace, they create an opportunity for restoration and renewal that reflects the beauty of God's design for this sacred covenant. Let us hold onto the hope that, with God, nothing is impossible, and even the most challenging marriages can experience transformation and healing.

#### Is Divorce the Unpardonable Sin?

Divorce, while deeply painful and not in line with God's ideal for marriage, is not the unpardonable sin. Scripture clarifies that the only sin beyond forgiveness is the blasphemy of the Holy Spirit (Matthew 12:31 32), a willful rejection of God's saving grace. Like all other sins or failures, divorce can be redeemed by God's grace through repentance and restoration. God's heart is always toward healing and reconciliation, both spiritually and emotionally. To condemn someone who has gone through a divorce is to misunderstand the breadth of God's mercy and the depth of His love for every individual. No one is beyond His grace, and He specializes in bringing beauty from ashes, even in the aftermath of broken relationships.

As believers, we must resist the tendency to look down on those who have experienced divorce, recognizing that we are all recipients of God's grace in our own brokenness. Divorce does not define a person's worth or their ability to serve God. Instead of judgment, the church is called to offer compassion, understanding, and support, helping individuals rebuild their lives on the foundation of God's love. When we label divorce as an unforgivable sin, we not only misrepresent God's character but also risk alienating people who desperately need His healing touch. Remember that the Gospel is a message of redemption for everyone, including those whose marriages have ended in divorce. Our responsibility is to extend the same grace and hope we have received, reflecting Christ's unconditional love.

Furthermore, it is important to recognize that life after divorce can still be filled with purpose and opportunity to serve God. Some of the most remarkable testimonies come from those who have

experienced brokenness and allowed God to restore them. Closing Thoughts Divorce, though painful, does not disqualify anyone from fulfilling God's plan for their life. In fact, it often becomes a platform for ministry, as those who have walked through this valley are uniquely equipped to offer hope and guidance to others in similar situations. The church should encourage those who have been divorced to seek healing and restoration, not only for themselves but also to minister to others in need.

Let us also consider Jesus' interactions with individuals who had experienced brokenness in their relationships, such as the woman at the well in John 4. Rather than condemning her for her multiple marriages, Jesus offered her the living water of salvation. His response reminds us that God's ultimate goal is not to shame but to redeem. When the church embodies this same attitude, it becomes a place of refuge and renewal for those who have endured the pain of divorce. In doing so, we reflect the heart of God, who longs to restore what is broken and use every life, regardless of its past, for His glory.

When it comes to marriage, conflicts will come. So, what do we do? When conflict arises in marriage, it is tempting to take the easy path and part ways, believing the situation to be beyond repair. Yet, in those moments of pain and struggle, it is crucial to remember the love that first brought you together and the covenant you made before God. Marriage is not just a human agreement; it is a sacred bond designed by God, and He is for your marriage. With His help, even the most challenging conflicts can be overcome, and relationships can be restored. God's power is limitless, and He specializes in taking broken things and making them whole.





parable of redemption. Born into a difficult background, he had early years marred by pain and instability. "My childhood wasn't always easy," he reflects. But amid the turmoil, the summers spent with his great uncle Tony provided a glimpse of peace and a deeper encounter with faith. These visits became a sanctuary, a contrast to the chaos that enveloped much of his early life.

At just fifteen, tragedy struck with the suicide of his mother. Grief overwhelmed Michael and his older brother, and they sought solace in addiction. Two years later, the death of Uncle Tony plunged Michael deeper into despair. What followed was a harrowing two-decade cycle of addiction, incarceration, and institutionalization. He was, as he describes, "trapped in a cycle of addiction, incarceration, institutions, and despair."

#### A Series of Miracles and a Turning Point

Michael's life hit a critical juncture in March 2017 when his brother died in a car accident. Emotionally devastated, Michael's path grew darker. But then, in August 2019, everything changed. He was hit by a truck and suffered critical injuries, including a severe brain injury. The accident became an unlikely catalyst for transformation.

"During my recovery, I had several near-death experiences," Michael shares. "I saw and felt the horrors of hell, but Jesus pulled me back with His grace and mercy." When he awoke, he was no longer the same man. "It was as if a weight had been lifted; pain, guilt, and addiction were gone. I was completely free for the first time in my life."

#### Music: A Ministry Born from Pain

Music, once a distant dream, has now become his ministry. The goal wasn't fame, it was freedom. Through his lyrics and melodies, he aimed to reach those still trapped in despair. From this redemption, a new calling emerged. A couple of years later, Michael began writing songs. "My first song came to me in November 2021, and I haven't stopped writing since," Michael explains.

to Blues. "When I first picked up a guitar, I dreamed of shredding like Eddie Van Halen and rocking out like Metallica," he says. But the trials of life changed his musical focus. Today, he finds inspiration in faith-based artists like Zach Williams, Casting Crowns, Devin Williams, Matthew West, Crowder, Ben Fuller, and Cochren & Co.

#### Rising on the Charts and in Spirit

The release of his debut album, "My Story," in November 2023 marked a significant milestone. It was a digital release, available across platforms like Spotify, Apple Music, and iTunes. But more than commercial reach, it was the message that mattered. In January 2024, his debut radio single By Your Side began gaining traction. It climbed the charts of Christian Voice Magazine, Cross Country USA, and Cashbox Magazine from March to August 2024.

His follow-up single, Forever Your Praises, released in June 2024, also resonated with listeners. By November, it appeared on five different charts and remained on the Cashbox Southern Gospel Chart at number 55 for two months. His latest single, His Name Is, released in January 2025, is debuting at number 91 on the Christian Voice Magazine Southern Gospel Top 100 this month.

While chart success is exciting, for Michael, it pales in comparison to the spiritual impact. "The impact I've witnessed through the 2nd Chance Ministry, which I was part of for almost three years, surpasses any stage," he affirms. "Seeing lives changed, chains of addiction and despair broken; that's absolutely amazing!"

#### A Love Story Forged in Faith

As he rebuilt his life, Michael encountered yet another miracle of love. After leaving the hospital in 2019 with only twenty dollars and no home, he witnessed God's providence in full. "Within hours, I was given a ride home, a place to stay, and food. Within days, I had my own place," he recalls.

He began attending a small country church, and one Sunday, he met a woman who would become his wife. "I knew instantly that she would be my wife," he smiles. A stolen church bell oddly became the conversation starter that united them. Today, she is Mrs. Walsh, and the couple shares two beautiful daughters, Faith and Hope.

#### A Testimony of Divine Intervention

One of the most profound moments in Michael's life came in December 2018, when he reached a point of hopelessness and attempted to end his life. Three different

methods failed miraculously. "The bullet was marked, exactly like the others I had shot before, but it didn't fire," he recounts. It was a chilling moment of divine intervention. "My life was spared for a third time that day by the mercies of my Lord and Savior, Christ Jesus."

#### **Fighting the Scourge of Addiction**

Michael's journey is inextricably linked to addiction; not Michael grew up listening to everything from Hard Rock just his own, but the broader crisis facing communities today. He speaks candidly about the epidemic, the rising potency of drugs, and the alarming rate of overdose deaths. "Addiction is a defining part of my story," he acknowledges. "Drugs and alcohol were a desperate attempt to silence internal pain." He views music ministries and recovery stories as vital tools in turning the tide. "Hope is the catalyst for change," he insists.

#### A Mission Bigger Than Music

Currently, Michael is putting the final touches on his second album, "The Way You Do," produced by NGP Studios in London, Kentucky. The first single is expected to be released this summer, bringing more faith-driven music to the

Looking to the future, Michael dreams of launching a deliverance ministry or supporting existing ones through his music. "My ultimate goal is for my music to have a positive, lasting impact on as many lives as possible," he says.

#### A Concert Experience Like No Other

For those attending a Michael Walsh concert, expect more than just music. It's a spiritual experience. "It's about genuine connection and heartfelt music. Anyone who shares the stage with me will be expected to give their absolute best, performing with the same reverence as if they were singing directly before the Lord", he says.

#### **Conclusion: A Life That Sings of Grace**

Michael Walsh's life is not just a comeback story: "it's a testimony to divine grace." Through trauma, addiction, loss, and near-death experiences, he has emerged not broken, but born anew. His music serves as both his message and his mission, reminding listeners that no pit is too deep for God's rescue. And with every song, he sings the truth he lives: that in Christ, every life, no matter how lost, can be transformed.



That rough and raw emotion you hear is real."

Janice Archer Cruse says, ""Legacy Medley" is a reminder of what has inspired us from the beginning - Jesus and the life change He brings to every situation. Nothing is ever more important than Him and His ability to guide and anoint the why and how of our music."

"As you listen to "Legacy Medley," you'll hear themes of prayer, hope, life, love and repentance," Tim adds. "No matter what we've done, or how broken we've become, He's right there offering hope and love with open hands. I hope this music will encourage listeners to make Christ the center of their lives."
























## Steven Curtis Chapman Celebrates the 25th Anniversary of 'Speechless' with Tour





## SAM BLANKENSHIP

If you've ever heard Southern Gospel music that made you feel like Heaven came a little closer, chances are you've encountered the anointed work of Sam Blankenship and Whosoever Ministries. Based in Cleveland, Tennessee, Sam's journey is one of faith, music, and a calling that started young and never let go.

Raised in church by his aunt and uncle, Sam fell in love with Gospel music early on. "I loved the piano and thought it was amazing. With lots of prayer, at the age of eleven, I started playing the piano," he says. Even more remarkable, he's never had a lesson. "It is a God-given talent... for that, I give God all the glory!"

His love for music turned into a ministry as he played for numerous groups over the years, but the tug to do more never left. That's when he stepped out in faith and formed his own group, Whosoever Ministries. The name came straight from scripture: Romans 10:13, "Whosoever calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." It's a powerful reminder of the inclusive nature of God's grace, and Sam's ministry has been built on that truth from the start.

In less than two years, the group has made an undeniable mark. Their first year included an astonishing 80 bookings without Sam making a single call. It's a clear testament to divine guidance. His motto - "God will open the doors and I will go through them," Sam believes.

With a live band and a full travel schedule, the work isn't easy, but it's rewarding. One moment that stands out is a powerful service in the Meigs County Jail. While Sam was singing, an inmate ran to the altar to surrender his life to Christ. That's the kind of impact Whosoever Ministries aims



for every single time they take the stage or the pulpit. Yes, the pulpit, too. Sam holds a doctorate in theology and has pastored churches in the past. Many of their bookings now include both preaching and singing, a combination that Sam considers a double blessing.

Their radio single, *God Reached Below the Bottom*, has been climbing the charts, debuting at #72 on the Cashbox Southern Gospel Top 100 and rising to #49 by April. It's also made the Christian Voice Magazine Top 100, a sign that their message is not only reaching ears, but hearts.

What can audiences expect when they experience Whosoever Ministries live? Sam puts it plainly: "We do not go to any singing to put on a show, we go to worship God through our music... We are on the same team, the Jesus team."

And with every note and every testimony, it's clear: "Whosoever Ministries isn't just performing; they're proclaiming."

#### Discover the Power of Hope

omans 15:13 says, "May the God of your hope so fill you with all joy and peace in believing .[through the experience of your faith] that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound and be overflowing (bubbling over) with hope" (AMPC).

Over the last 45-plus years I've spent traveling and teaching God's Word around the world, I've met many incredible people from nearly every walk of life. Some were doing great, seemingly on top of the world. Others confided in me that they were barely getting by, living day-to-day, trying to make ends meet. And many others were dealing with circumstances so difficult that, quite frankly, they felt defeated and overwhelmed by life.

And no matter who we are or what our situation, HOPE is one thing we all desperately need. The reason is: hope is powerful!

Hope is more than a motivational thought or a fading daydream - hope is a nothing-is-impossible-with-God firestorm refusing to be quenched. It's an awareness that God is actually expecting, looking, and longing to show you His goodness. Hope is what stabilizes your frantic thoughts and emotions - it's an awareness that there is no problem big enough to keep God from rescuing you.

These days, it's easy to be worn down by hopelessness. People lose hope when they experience overwhelming loss, repeated failures, impossible situations, or when they're hurt by people they trust. Like most of you, I understand what it's like to feel hopeless. I spent 23 years of my life filled with pain, abuse, disappointment, unfaithfulness, and one bad thing after another.

Because of this, I wouldn't get my hopes up. I used to say, "If I don't expect anything good to happen, I won't be disappointed when it doesn't." But when I got serious about my relationship with God and began studying His Word, I discovered real hope. I learned why hope is important, and how powerful hope can be.

Hope is a positive expectation that something good is going to happen to you because of God's great goodness. It is not a wishy-washy, vague, wait-and-see attitude, but an action we must choose to take on purpose each day. Hope and faith go hand in hand.

Hope also enables us to endure hardships and long waiting periods, and God uses these times to develop character and endurance in us. Psalm 27:14 says, "Wait and hope for and expect the Lord; be brave and of good courage and let your heart be stout and enduring. Yes, wait for and hope for and expect the Lord" (AMPC).

Hope dares us to believe! It thinks, "You know what? Things might just work out after all." It's the sometimes unexplainable, but always undeniable, feeling that today would be a bad day to give up.

Isaiah 40:31 tells us: "But they who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint" (ESV).

Regardless of who you are or what condition your life is in, you can't function successfully without hope in God. If circumstances are bad, you surely need hope. And if they are good, you need hope that they will stay that way!

Hope energizes and motivates us to take action by causing We will all battle hopelessness at some point in our lives. us to step out in faith and act in obedience with God's Word. Hope believes boldly, decides daringly, speaks firmly, and perseveres passionately. When we embrace hope on purpose, it influences our thoughts, our attitudes, our outlook, and the way we speak. Hope builds us up as we wait on God.

> Hope releases joy, and the joy of the Lord becomes our source of strength (Nehemiah 8:10). Never assume that where you've been or where you are is as good as it gets. And when your goal or your situation seems impossible, keep in mind that nothing is impossible for God.

> In Matthew 19:26, Jesus said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible" (NIV). It doesn't matter what the situation looks like around you; God is greater than any obstacle you may be facing. Everything that has never been done is impossible until someone does it, so why can't it be you?

> Don't allow your mind to become a hindrance to the things you can accomplish in life. Think big - the way God does! Choose to believe God is going to do something better in your life. So, go ahead and get your hopes up! God is leading you to something better than you can imagine!



## Remembering...

### GARRY JONES • SQUIRE PARSONS HUEY P, WILLIAMS • LULU ROMAN CHARLES ABEE

Huey P. Williams September 21, 1938 - March 24, 2025

Huey P. Williams was born in 1938 into Gospel music royalty. He was the older brother of Frank Williams, who founded the Mississippi Mass Choir, and of Melvin, Doug, and Leonard Williams, members of the Grammy-nominated Williams Brothers. The Williams family is widely recognized for its significant influence in shaping the sound of modern Gospel.

As the longtime front man with The Jackson Southernaires, Williams' unmistakable voice and soulful storytelling made him one of the most beloved vocalists in the genre. He is revered as a trailblazer in traditional Gospel.

The Jackson Southernaires, founded in 1940 in Jackson, Mississippi, rose to national prominence in the 1960s with the breakout single, *The Greatest Creator*, released in 1963. *Too Late* (1968) became a major success, leading to the release of the group's first full-length album. Other fan

favorites include Don't Let Him Catch You (With Your Work Undone) and How Long Will It Last.

In 1975, the group became the first Gospel act to sign with Malaco Records, where it released projects that charted on Billboard's Top Gospel Albums list, such as "Down Home" (1975), "Legendary Gentlemen" (1979), and "Lord We Need Your Blessing" (1985). They were frequently named among Billboard's 'Top Gospel/Soul Artists of the Year.'

The Jackson Southernaires won multiple accolades, including three consecutive Gospel Music Workshop of America awards for 'Traditional Male Group of the Year' in the late '80s, a Stellar Award in 1989, and a Grammy nomination in 1992. They were inducted into the Mississippi Musicians Hall of Fame, and in 2010, the city of Jackson renamed a stretch of road in their honor: Jackson Southernaires Drive.

Huey's commitment to Gospel never wavered. When asked if he'd ever retire, he famously replied, "My answer to that question is, how do you give up on God? How do you give up on Gospel? How do you say, 'I'm going to retire?' It's like a good marriage - until death do us part."

Williams' final performance with the group was in late 2024, a testament to his enduring passion for Gospel. On March 24, 2025, he died peacefully at his home in Smithdale, Mississippi. He was 86 years old. His passing marks the end of an era for quartet Gospel - a style he helped define and preserve for over five decades.

"My big brother Huey, in my eyes, was in a league of his own," said Doug, who is one of his brothers. "He possessed a signature voice that was unmistakably his own. His music ministry touched so many lives in such a positive way over the years. He had a big personality, but such a humble spirit. Huey was the epitome of a people's person, a man who loved everybody and never met a stranger. He would literally give you the shirt off his back. That's why so many people from across the country gravitated to him and loved him dearly. His presence will be sorely missed, but his undeniable legacy will live on forever."



**LuLu Roman**May 6, 1946 - April 23, 225

Born Bertha Louise Hable on May 6, 1946, in Dallas, Texas, Lulu's life was a testament to the power of perseverance. Raised in an orphanage after a challenging childhood marked by abandonment, she transformed adversity into a radiant career that spanned music, comedy, and ministry.

Her indomitable spirit and infectious joy propelled her to stardom, beginning with her breakout role as a founding cast member of Hee Haw in 1969. Alongside Country music legends like Roy Clark and Buck Owens, Lulu's comedic brilliance, hearty laugh, and commanding singing voice made her a household name. Her performances brought warmth and humor to generations of viewers, cementing her as a cornerstone of the show's legacy and a beloved figure in television history.

Lou's talents extended far beyond the screen. As a trailblazer in Gospel music, she released over a dozen albums, which showcased her soulful voice and deeply personal faith. Her music earned her a Grammy nomination, a Dove Award from the Gospel Music Association, and a 1999 induction into the Country Gospel Music Hall of Fame.

Lou's concerts were more than performances - they were spiritual gatherings filled with hope, testimony, and connection. Her openness about her struggles with addiction and her transformative journey to Christianity in the 1970s resonated deeply, offering inspiration to those facing their trials. Her story of redemption became a cornerstone of her ministry, as she shared her faith through music, speaking engagements, and outreach.

Her unwavering love for her family defined Lulu's life. She often spoke of her sons, Damon and Justin, as her greatest blessings. Sadly, Justin passed away in 2017, a loss that profoundly shaped her heart and deepened her faith.

Beyond her professional achievements, Lou passionately advocated for causes close to her heart. Drawing from her own experiences, she supported organizations focused on children's welfare, addiction recovery, adoption, foster care, and heart health. She frequently spoke at churches, recovery centers, and prisons, using humor, humility, and testimony to uplift those struggling with hardship. Her compassion for the broken and her commitment to sharing hope made her a beacon of light for countless individuals, inspiring them to find purpose and healing.

Louise "Lulu" Roman, beloved Country and Gospel music artist, comedian, and cherished star of the iconic television show Hee Haw. aged 78, passed away unexpectedly on the evening of April 23, 2025. Her departure leaves an irreplaceable void in the hearts of her family, friends, and millions of fans worldwide, but her legacy of laughter, faith, and resilience will endure forever.

Her family and friends will forever cherish her infinite kindness, quick wit, and generous spirit, which touched everyone she met.



Garry Jones September 16, 1962 – April 27, 2025

Born in Fort Walton Beach, Florida on September 16, 1962, Garry Ray Jones was one of four children born to Jerry and Loraine Jones. He had a long and celebrated career in Gospel music, first gaining national attention with the Pensacola, Florida-based group, the Dixie Echoes. However, he rose to his most notable position with the award-winning Gold City Quartet, which he joined in 1981. He was the group's pianist and eventual producer/arranger and is credited

for establishing the Gold City sound of the 1980's and early 1990's. Garry's musical creativity was heard on such songs as When I Get Carried Away, One Scarred Hand, There Rose A Lamb, and the group's signature song, Midnight Cry.

During his time with Gold City, Garry was awarded the Singing News Fan Award for 'Favorite Musician' in 1990 and 1991. A tenure spanning 13 years with Gold City, Garry, affectionately known as Taco, later went on to play for The Old Friends Quartet and was a founding member of both Ernie Haase and Signature Sound and Mercy's Mark.

In 2017, Garry was inducted, as a member of Gold City, into the Gospel Music Association Hall of Fame. After spending some time doing other endeavors, Garry had recently returned to his roots, once again producing the music of Gold City. He co-produced their 2024 recording, "Right Now" and penned several songs on that project. Gold City's latest chart single, Rise Up, was written by Garry, and is currently climbing radio charts across the nation.

Award-winning musician and producer, Garry Jones passed away on Sunday evening, April 27, 2025, after a brief battle with metastatic cancer. He was 62 years old.

Immediately following the announcement of his passing, tributes began pouring in from the members of Gold City. Danny Riley stated, "Our Gold City family has heavy hearts, as we have lost not only a great musician and producer, but also a dear friend. Garry was an incredible talent who was responsible for a lot of the group's early success in the 1980's to mid-1990's. I've known him since I was a kid. I think shocked and devastated would be how we feel as a group right now. Garry has left us way too soon. Our hearts go out to his family during this time, and we would ask you pray for them in the days ahead."

Josh Feemster, lead vocalist for Gold City adds, "Garry was a great friend of mine. He gave me my first job in Gospel Music as a member of Mercy's Mark. He was currently working with Gold City, producing new music for us. Nobody really knew how to get that Gold City sound for us better than Garry, because he helped create it from the beginning. This is a huge loss for a lot of people, including Gold City and myself personally. But I am so thankful to the Lord for allowing us the opportunity to work together again these past Beverley And Sister Annie Laura. few years."

Gold City manager Joel Stapleton shared, "Garry's impact on our music, ministry, and lives will never be forgotten. When he came aboard to produce the last half of Gold City's current album, he really helped breathe new life into our recording process. We will miss him greatly, but we rejoice in knowing he's safe in the arms of Jesus now."

Charles Abee April 7, 1943 – April 29, 2025

Born April 7, 1943, Charles Abee most heavily impacted Gospel music as a pianist during the 1960s and 1970s. He first surfaced on the professional scene in 1965 with The Pine Ridge Boys, later joining The Palmetto State Quartet.

He is best known for his tenure with the Kingsmen Quartet from 1971 to 1973, during which they first became known as "The Ton of Fun." During this period, he played a pivotal role in shaping the group's sound, contributing to albums such as "America's Favorite Hymns" (1971) and "May Day" (1972). Abee was also credited with coining the group's nickname, "The Men of Music," reflecting their dynamic and evolving musical style.

Abee played on numerous early Kingsmen hits including Just As The Sun Went Down, The Apple Tree Story, Gone, I'd Rather Be An Old Time Christian, and Reverend Everette

After Abee left the full-time circuit, he remained active with several regional groups such as Meetin' Time Quartet, The Tarheel State Quartet, and Men Of Praise, in addition to serving for 24 years as Minister of Music at Winklers Grove Baptist Church in Morganton, North Carolina. He was a recipient of both the 2004 Living Legend Award at the Grand Ole Gospel Reunion, and a 2011 inductee into the Southern Gospel Piano Roll of Honor.

Charles Abee, the esteemed Southern Gospel pianist renowned for his contributions to the Kingsmen Quartet during the early 1970s, passed away on April 29, 2025, at the age of 82.



#### **Squire Parsons**

April 4, 1948 – May 5, 2025

Born April 4, 1948, Squire Parsons, Jr. began singing Southern Gospel music professionally when he joined West Virginia's Calvarymen Quartet in 1969. By 1975, Mr. Parsons

had joined The Kingsmen, serving as the quartet's baritone vocalist for most of his tenure there. During his time with The Kingsmen, Mr. Parsons' voice was heard on several songs that have gone on to become classics - It Made News In Heaven, Hello Mama, The Lovely Name Of Jesus, I've Got A Reservation, Master Of The Sea, Look For Me At Jesus' Feet, and numerous others.

Following his departure from The Kingsmen in 1979, Mr. Parsons began focusing on a solo ministry and songwriting, and it was during this

time that the Gospel music community was introduced to even more songs that touched the hearts and lives of people around the world. Sweet Beulah Land, He Came To Me, The Broken Rose, The Greatest Of All Miracles, I'm Not Giving Up, I Sing Because, and I Call It Home are just a few of the songs that Mr. Parsons shared with the world. Mr. Parsons was also ordained as a minister in 1979 at his home church, Trinity Baptist Church in Asheville, North Carolina.

In addition to a solo ministry, Mr. Parsons was responsible for two groups that served Gospel music well: Squire Parsons & Redeemed (1984-1991) and The Squire Parsons Trio (1995-2009). During the year 1992, The Squire Parsons Quartet made limited appearances with a line-up that included Ernie Phillips, Arthur Rice, Joe Fowler, and Mr. Parsons.

During Mr. Parsons' professional singing career, he was honored numerous times for his contributions to Gospel music. The readers of Singing News Magazine presented Mr. Parsons the award for 'Favorite Baritone' (1986-1987), 'Favorite Male Singer' (1988), and 'Favorite Songwriter' (1986, 1992, 1993, 1994, 1995). His song, *Sweet Beulah Land* was voted 'Song Of The Year' in 1981. Mr. Parsons was inducted in the Southern Gospel Music Hall of Fame in 2008 and he was also inducted in the Gospel Music Association's Hall of Fame in 2000 as a former member of The Kingsmen.

Though he continued to make limited appearances in his home area of Asheville, North Carolina, Mr. Parsons retired from traveling in 2019 due to health concerns. Even while facing several serious health issues in his mid-to-late 70s, Mr. Parsons' powerful voice could often be heard during regular services and revivals at Trinity Baptist Church.



At age 77, legendary Southern Gospel singer and songwriter Squire Parsons went home to be with the Lord on May 5, 2025. Known for his powerful voice, heartfelt lyrics, and unwavering faith, Parsons left a lasting legacy in the world of Southern Gospel music.

















arroll Roberson's life story reads like a tapestry woven with faith, resilience, and purpose. Born and raised in rural Mississippi, just a few miles from Ripley, his upbringing was marked by simplicity and hardship. His father, Marshall, could neither read nor write, and his mother, Lois, worked tirelessly for the family with very little pay. These humble beginnings planted the seeds of gratitude and perseverance in Carroll and his brother, Stan. Guitar lessons from his father and a home built on character and faith shaped the foundation of his future calling.

#### From Funeral Song to Gospel Stardom

Roberson's journey into full-time evangelism began almost unexpectedly at a funeral in 1985. A local funeral home owner, Willie McBride, heard Carroll sing and instantly recognized his natural gift. McBride funded Roberson's first professional album, taking a leap of faith when Nashville's music industry wouldn't. That gamble paid off.

Carroll's version of *This Ole House* soared into the top 40 within two weeks, paving the way for a contract with the Eddie Crook Company. The late 1980s and 1990s saw a string of top 10 Gospel hits and two #1 songs: Wilt Thou Be Made Whole and Just Go By.

Carroll started his own record label in 1996, and has enjoyed several more #1 songs like, Good Mornin' Lord, The Way We Should Live, Jesus Says Hello, Jesus Put my Life Together, and many other top ten songs.

#### A Defining Encounter and a New Direction

Though Carroll believed in Christ from childhood, it wasn't until 1983 that he fully surrendered to Him. "At the age of twenty-eight, being convicted by the Holy Spirit, I surrendered my life to Jesus Christ," Carroll recounts.

This life-altering decision was soon followed by a cancer diagnosis, threatening his ability to sing. Shortly after his conversion to Christ, he had a cancerous tumor removed from his throat... but the gracious Lord had other plans. Not only did Carroll recover, but this trial also became a divine turning point. Within two years, he felt the unmistakable call to ministry.

#### A Musical Signature Beyond Labels

While Nashville tried to define him within traditional genres, Carroll Roberson's sound remained uniquely his own. Raised on the music of Marty Robbins, Glen Campbell, and Elvis, Carroll infused his Gospel compositions with familiar Country and Bluegrass rhythms. "Carroll's music is not Southern Gospel, or Country, or Bluegrass, or Contemporary; it is just simply Carroll Roberson," noted one DJ. Over the a life that reflects Christ to the world.

#### Preacher First, Musician Always


Despite his fame as a singer and songwriter, Carroll never lost sight of his primary calling: preaching the Word of God. He notes, "Whatever our gift is, preaching or singing, we should make sure that our motive is pure and never lose our personal, God-given identity."

Carroll's preaching is direct and rooted in Biblical authenticity. "I believe in presenting the Bible in its original context. I believe in living out the Christian faith," he says. His sermons reject modern compromise and emphasize living

#### Israel: A Spiritual Awakening

One of the most transformative chapters in Roberson's ministry began in 1991, when he led his first tour to Israel. "To be on the Sea of Galilee and grasping that God in Heaven has called you to be one of his servants, is a most exciting, humbling experience," he reflects. Since then, Carroll and his wife, Donna, have guided more than thirty-five pilgrimages to the Holy Land. Their tours, branded as Jesus Isreal Tours, have led thousands to a deeper understanding of the Jewish roots of Christianity.

Roberson also emphasizes, "Gentile Christians do not have to get caught up in Jewish traditions, but without a Jewish context it is impossible to have a true interpretation of the sacred scriptures." His long-time study of Hebrew and the Biblical origins of Christianity has enriched his preaching and teaching, making his commentaries widely appreciated among believers seeking depth and authenticity.



#### From Stage to Screen: Reaching the World

Recognizing the limits of the traditional Gospel music circuit, Carroll expanded his outreach through television and digital platforms. His weekly show, "This is Carroll Roberson" aired on many TV markets for years, and now he is reaching a new audience through his YouTube Channel, with over 140,000 subscribers and millions of viewers from across the US and around the world. Carroll's TV producer

David Webb decided years ago that Carroll's songs would appeal to a larger audience being filmed with the background of beautiful outdoor scenery like the Grand Teton Mountains, Monument Valley, Arizona, Colorado, with heartfelt messages in song and Word. Carroll continues to innovate, inspire, and evangelize.

#### **A Ministry Without Boundaries**

Carroll Roberson Ministries remains a debt-free, evangelistic association dedicated to spreading the Gospel without seeking grandeur. The organization hosts the annual Jesus Isreal Conference in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee, drawing attendees from far and wide. Though road dates are limited, Carroll's ministry impacts countless lives in the U.S., Europe, India, Africa, and beyond.

The simplicity of his mission belies its profound reach. From churches using his sermons in distant lands to individuals discovering his music online, the ministry's fruit is evident. Roberson declares, "Seeing the Holy Spirit touch so many people through this ministry is the greatest of all awards."

#### Looking Ahead with Faith

Now celebrating 40 years in full-time evangelism, Carroll Roberson remains steadfast in his calling. The accolades may be many, but his focus is unchanged: "to serve God with integrity and passion".

"God doesn't need all of us trying to do the same thing. His kingdom is so vast that there is room for all of us!" Carroll says.

Carroll continues to record new songs and film Bible devotions for His YouTube channel. Social media has opened new doors for him to share Christ in Word and song to countless people. Carroll even tries to personally answer most of the messages that His ministry is getting, many times seeing profound spiritual results. One lady writes from Brazil, "It sounds too simple to call you Bro. Carroll, your ministry of Bible messages and music have really made a difference in my life and my family." - Suzanne Barry, Brazil, South America



### **California Parents Finally Find Ally in Legal Fight Over 'Kinder Buddy'**

In liberal-run California, where a 2024 law bans parental notification in schools, some parents can point to a narrow legal victory in their ongoing fight against gender-based indoctrination.

In its 14-page ruling, the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of California told Encinitas Union School District it must notify parents if gender ideology is a classroom topic in its "Kinder Buddy" program.

The ruling, which granted a preliminary injunction, was signed by U.S. District Judge James Lorenz. He directly tells the Northern California school district it "shall not" cover gender identity topics unless Encinitas provides parents with advance notice and an opportunity to opt out.

Even though the California ruling is narrow, since it affects only Encinitas schools, a similar case went before the U.S. Supreme Court in mid-April. That case, Mahmoud v. Taylor, was brought by Maryland parents who are likely to win their appeal according to news reports.

Mahmoud v. Taylor also involves an LGBT-themed children's book, "Pride Puppy," and a liberal school district that refused to allow an opt-out option that was based on religious objections.

Representing two sets of Encinitas parents, First Liberty Institute and the National Center for Law & Policy filed a complaint and motion for preliminary injunction in September 2024.

The 57-page lawsuit names as defendants Encinitas Union superintendent and an assistant superintendent; the La Costa Heights principal; two La Costa Heights teachers; and the five Encinitas Union school board members.

Before that lawsuit was filed, AFN reported in a previous story how a parent named Carlos Encinas learned his fifth-grade son was forced to watch a read-along video for "My Shadow is Pink," a transgender-friendly children's book.

The father was never informed by LaCosta Elementary it after his son complained he had been paired with a kindergartener for the school's "Kinder Buddy" program.

After news of the book reading spread, Encinas and other parents swarmed a school board meeting to demand a parental notification and opt-out polices.

"We the people have the freedom to opt-out," one outraged parent told the school board. "We are going to opt-out as Christians. If you don't accept our opt-out, we'll see you in court."

When the school board ignored their pleas, Encinas became a co-plaintiff in the lawsuit that cites his Christian faith. "Plaintiff Parents believe the School District should not encourage their

minor children to question their God-given sex or gender," the complaint states.

Nate Kellum, a First Liberty attorney, tells AFN the so-called "buddy classes" were really a tool for using older students to indoctrinate kindergarteners.

"They were actually forcing these kids to teach it to younger kids," he says. "So not only were they doing this, but they were keeping the parents out of the loop."

In the ruling, Judge Lorenz points out the buddy class was allowing students to pick the books to read and a weekly newsletter informed parents of the book list. At some point, however, a LaCosta teacher chose "My Shadow is Pink" and that selection was not listed in the newsletter.

Farther down in the ruling, AFN found Judge Lorenz was unpersuaded by the school district's claim the fifth grader was not harmed by "My Shadow in Pink" because he did not complain to the teacher.

The school district also argued the student's participation was not "compelled," because the parents are not claiming non-participation would result in punishment, but the judge pointed out Encinitas had acknowledged participation in the buddy program is mandatory.

### **Heretical Denomination Adds** 'Racist' to its Description

An Episcopal ministry that usually helps resettle refugees in the U.S. is refusing to help the few dozen South Africans the Trump administration has welcomed in – because they are white.

Migration Ministries is also cancelling its entire contract with the government. "We can't be ourselves in the Episcopal Church and take this step of resettling white Afrikaners from South Africa," Presiding Bishop Sean Rowe explains regarding the decision. "Our church has a long commitment to racial justice and reconciliation."

49 Afrikaners had been expected, but 59 arrived in May, including toddlers and other small children. Trump told reporters that he was admitting them as refugees because of School about the controversial book, and he only learned about the "genocide that's taking place" in their post-apartheid homeland.

> "It has been painful to watch one group of refugees, selected in a highly unusual manner, receive preferential treatment over many others who have been waiting in refugee camps or dangerous conditions for years," Bishop Rowe laments.

> Bishop Vincent Mathews of Project 21, however, says the denomination is purposefully violating a biblical mandate. "The scripture tells us that we should not have respecter of persons," Mathews notes. "This is a bad look for the church."

> He points out that this is not the first time the Episcopal Church has defied scripture; Mathews says they disqualified

themselves from biblical ministry decades ago, when they welcomed immoral sexual relationships. "They could be salt and light in a difficult time and really minister to some people, but they have really kind of fumbled that opportunity," he concludes.

Bishop Rowe says Christians must not be guided by "political vagaries," but he also insists the denomination's partnership with government, particularly the new administration, is "no longer viable."

He has asked for prayer for the persecuted President Trump has not regarded as refugees and hopes private sponsors will provide the funds needed to eventually revamp the resettlement ministry, as he knows the forfeited \$50 million in annual federal funds cannot be covered by current donations or investment proceeds.

### They're Not Just Killing Babies; They're Mutilating Minors

An undercover video investigation appears to show Planned Parenthood offering to help minors get cross-sex hormones – at taxpayers' expense.

The new video from Live Action features an employee posing as a minor and calling different Planned Parenthoods to ask about getting cross-sex hormones. In many cases, she is told she could go ahead and begin the process, even though she just decided to transition in recent days.

Her supposed age of 16 also did not matter, with one Planned Parenthood staffer telling the operative that her mother did not have to be with her for her whole visit to the clinic. Another said that her consultation could be done virtually. Meanwhile, no therapy was required prior to getting the hormones.

This is not the first time Live Action has done an undercover report, but it is the first one that specifically looks at Planned Parenthood through the lens of gender manipulation or, as some describe, "trans healthcare."

"We know Planned Parenthood is killing babies – 400,000 a year, their new annual report shows," notes Live Action's Noah Brandt. "We also know that Planned Parenthood is mutilating older children who are already born by putting them on really challenging paths that can ultimately sterilize them and harm them for the rest of their lives via cross-sex hormones."

The video comes at a time in which Live Action and many other pro-life organizations are calling on Congress to defund Planned Parenthood through reconciliation – something Brandt calls a no-brainer.

He says when Americans learn that Planned Parenthood is the nation's largest abortion chain and the nation's largest trans organization for minors, their support for defunding Planned Parenthood skyrockets; their opinion of Planned Parenthood plummets.

"The truth is there are a lot of Republicans in Congress who are even more incensed and care more about the trans issue than the life and abortion issue," says Brandt. "So, talking about the trans issue as we debate this bill to Defund Planned Parenthood is crucial."

### Will Media Keep Trusting Terrorists Who Sacrifice Kids to Lead the News?

Even after a British think tank studied civilian casualties in the Gaza Strip, which debunked propaganda by Hamas, a media analyst predicts liberal news outlets will stick to their talking points anyway.

Every civilian death in war is tragic, but the Jew-killing terrorist group Hamas is infamous for sacrificing its own civilians, including children, to stir up world anger at Israel and the Jews.

After the surprise Hamas attack in Israel 1 1/2 years ago, which killed 1,200 Israelis, Hamas now claims 70% of the Palestinians killed by the IDF in Gaza are innocent women and children. A new study by the Henry Jackson Society, however, says Hamas is exaggerating the deaths of its own civilians and hiding the deaths of its military-age males. Looking at hospital records from the Gaza Ministry of Health, the Society says women and children officially accounted for 51% of deaths so far.

While that figure is tragic, the Society points out it is Hamas that forces its civilian population to remain in a combat zone even after the IDF publicly urged civilians to flee the fighting. That occurred in Khan Younis, a city in southern Gaza, in 2023, according to a Fox News story.

A phone call recorded by the IDF showed a Palestinian man telling the IDF that civilians in Khan Younis were being told by Hamas to remain in their homes. Among the official hospital casualty numbers from the Ministry of Health, 76% were male of which 58% of those men are fighting age. In its own casualty statistics, the Ministry of Health doesn't identify any dead combatants even though the IDF says it has killed 20,000 fighters to date.

Dan Schneider, of the Media Research Center, says the liberal media repeats the Hamas propaganda because most reporters, correspondents and editors are "hard-left people" who hate Israel.


Even though the study puts the number of civilian casualties at 50%, Schneider says even that sad statistic is misleading because Hamas uses its own people as human shields. "Is a 19-year-old carrying a fully automatic weapon, shooting at Jews, is that a child?" he asks. "Or just because somebody is a woman does not mean the person is not also a terrorist."

Back in the United States, Schneider points out the liberal media also manipulates public opinion to create anger and sympathy. The media, for example, used the story of a deported MS-13 gang member in order to attack the Trump administration and its immigration policy.

More recently than that, Schneider points out CNN tracked down a literal Mexican gang member for a news segment attacking Trump. "One of our major news outlets interviewed a human trafficker and was asking how that human trafficker feels now that Donald Trump is clamping down on his business."





















### A Preacher's Perspective


I'm reminded of Job, a man that God declared as "perfect and upright...and


Tatherhood is one of the most profound gifts God Moments That Shape a Father's Heart has given to mankind. It is more than a role or to reflect the love, wisdom, and grace of our Heavenly Father. In embracing fatherhood, a man steps into a journey that is deeply spiritual, full of challenges, joys, and countless moments of reflection. ### **Spicy Meat Loaf**

2 lbs. ground chuck 1 egg 1/4 cup bread crumbs 1 medium onion, chopped 1/2 bell pepper, chopped



1 1/2 stalks celery, finely chopped (optional)

1 clove garlic, minced

Salt and pepper to taste

1 teaspoon sage

2 tablespoons horseradish

1/2 cup grated cheese

1 cup barbecue sauce (I use my bbq sauce recipe)

1/2 teaspoon dry ground mustard

Mix all ingredients except for 1/2 of the barbecue sauce. Put in loaf pan. Bake at 350 for 30 minutes. Pour remaining barbecue sauce and bake for an additional 15 minutes.

### **Sausage and Cream Cheese Pinwheels**

1 can crescent rolls
1 lb. bulk sausage
1 8-oz. block of cream cheese (room temperature)
1/2 teaspoon chives
Dash garlic powder

Preheat oven to 370°. Brown sausage and drain. Blend garlic powder and chives to cream cheese with a fork in a large bowl. Roll out crescent rolls into one rectangle on floured surface, pinching perforated edges together.

### **Spinach Madeline**

2 10 oz. Boxes Frozen Chopped Spinach

1 Onion (chopped)

4 Tablespoons Butter

2 Tablespoons Flour

1/2 Cup Milk

1/2 Cup Spinach Liquor (liquid from cooked spinach)

**Bread Crumbs** 

1 Teaspoon Worcestershire Sauce

1/2 Teaspoon Black Pepper

1/4 Teaspoon Celery Salt

\*6-8 oz. Velveeta Cheese

\*1 Teaspoon Jalapeno Pepper (chopped)

Dash Cayenne Pepper

\*Can substitute Mexican Velveeta for these 2 items

Cook spinach according to box. Drain saving liquor. Set aside.

Sautee onions in butter until soft. Stir in flour and milk. Stir in spices, Worcestershire Sauce, and jalapenos. Add spinach liquor slowly. Add cubed Velveeta. Stir until cheese is melted. Add spinach. Stir until mixed thoroughly. Pour into a casserole dish. Sprinkle with bread crumbs and place pats of butter on top. Cook for 20 minutes or until bubbly and brown in a 350 degree oven.

### **Savory Chicken and Rice**

Water

2 chicken breasts
2 cups rice
1 cup cream of mushroom soup
1/8 teaspoon garlic powder
1/2 teaspoon chives
2 teaspoons chicken bouillon crystals



Cook chicken in pot with enough water to cover. Add bouillon crystals. When done, add rice. Keep close check and add water as needed. Shred chicken with a couple of forks. When rice is done, add garlic powder and chives and soup. If it is too dry add a little water at a time to get to right consistency. Serve hot.



Mix sausage and cream cheese mixture together. Evenly spread mixture close to the edges on the crescent roll rectangle. Roll long ends and secure edge. Gently cut with a serrated knife as to not mash

Place on baking sheet. Bake for 20-25 minutes until golden brown.
















A 25-Year Journey of Music, Ministry, and Miracles

# SACRED HARMONY

In 2000, Janet Weaver followed a divine calling and formed what would soon become one of the most distinctive and anointed groups in Gospel music, Sacred Harmony. Celebrating their 25th anniversary in 2025, the Tennessee-based trio has cultivated a ministry that resonates far beyond the walls of the church. With a unique blend of traditional Gospel, Bluegrass, Country, and Contemporary Christian music, Sacred Harmony continues to break barriers while staying grounded in their mission: "Lifting up Jesus through every note and lyric."

Te truly appreciate each church, each blessed to worship with," says Janet Weaver, the founding member and soul of Sacred Harmony. A voice known for its soft and sweet high tenor/alto tones, Janet brings warmth and harmony not only to the music but to the entire ministry.

With a rich musical heritage, most notably her brother, Wayne Little of the legendary Blackwood Brothers Quartet, Janet's dedication is unwavering.

### Evolving Lineups, Unchanging Mission

Sacred Harmony began as a trio, became a quartet for Breaking Barriers with a Unique Sound nearly fourteen years, and eventually returned to its original trio format, where it has remained for the past eleven years. Despite the evolving lineups, one thing has remained consistent: the group's commitment to powerful, spirit-led worship.

Joining Janet in the current formation are Caleb Howard and Melissa Evans, each bringing their own rich musical backgrounds and spiritual depth to the trio. Caleb, a phenomenal soloist and evangelist from Eastern Kentucky, continues to minister both independently and with Sacred Harmony.

His solo career has produced multiple #1 hits, including Just Another Storm, Bring It All, and Water Grave. With a heart rooted in ministry, Caleb shares, "My goal is the same today as it was then, to lift up Jesus in every song and message in the best way possible. To see the lost and to make God's glory known to all who will listen."

Melissa Evans, an award-winning solo artist, originally concert, and each person that we are joined Sacred Harmony in 2016 as a fill-in vocalist. She now travels full-time with the group while continuing her solo ministry. Her journey began in 2005 with the group Face Like Flint and expanded through prison ministries and feeding programs. Her current single, One Touch From Jesus, is climbing the charts. "I am thankful for my calling and for God's unconditional love for me. Where He leads, I will follow," Melissa expresses.

When Caleb is away for evangelistic work, Sacred "My desire is that God uses this ministry that He started Harmony is blessed with Greg Odom, a devoted deacon and worship team member, as their fill-in vocalist. Known for his diverse musical style and infectious spirit, Greg, along with his wife, Charity, and daughter, Kylie, brings additional strength and support to the ministry.

Over the years, Sacred Harmony has graced stages alongside icons like The Hoppers, Jason Crabb, The Blackwood Brothers, The Guardians, and even secular legends such as Larry Gatlin and TG Sheppard. Their performance at the American Gospel Celebration hosted by Pastor John Hagee stands out as a ministry highlight. From major events like the National Quartet Convention, Dollywood, and The Ark Encounter to humble country churches, their message remains the same: "It's not about where they sing, but who they sing about."

This versatile style has led to collaborations that have elevated the group's national profile. Their 2016 breakthrough album, "Believe," featured the Grammy-winning Fairfield Four and produced hits like Jesus Did What He Came to Do and Grave Robber. It wasn't long before accolades followed, including 'Sunrise Trio of the Year' at the 2017 SGN Scoops Diamond Awards and a proclamation of 'A Day of Recognition' by Tennessee Governor Bill Haslam in 2018.

### A Ministry of Resilience and Revival

In 2020, during a time of global upheaval, Sacred Harmony leaned into their calling more than ever. Their powerful album "It Ain't Over Yet," recorded at the renowned Blackbird Studio in Nashville, mirrored the trials and hope of the times. With radio hits like *Sing Joy to the World, Breathe In, Breathe Out,* and the titular *It Ain't Over Yet*, the group affirmed that even amidst chaos, God was still moving. The project's accompanying video, produced by Godsey Media, brought their ministry to even broader audiences online.

Their 2022 Christmas CD, recorded at Zenith Studio with Scott Godsey and Paul Secord, ushered in a worshipful season. 2024 brought even more success with *Worship My Way Home* and *Turn Your Eyes*, both reaching Top 40 status and solidifying the group's position in both Gospel and Faith Country charts. Their current single, *I Can Count on the One*, is already climbing charts and reminding listeners of God's unfailing presence.

### Looking Ahead with Passion and Purpose

2025 is shaping up to be a monumental year for Sacred Harmony. Two new projects, "In His Eyes" and "A Solitary Place," were recently recorded at Daywind Studios. The latter, though a solo project by Janet, features the trio's harmonies throughout and includes a touching duet with her late brother Wayne Little, an emotional tribute made possible by blending their separate recordings.

Sacred Harmony is also expanding into television ministry with "Behind the Scenes with Sacred Harmony," a streaming show airing on WATC TV57. This show allows fans to engage with the group beyond the stage and witness the heart and preparation behind their performances.

### Empowered to Shine, Anointed to Serve

Sacred Harmony's journey is as much about spiritual growth as musical evolution: "Be true to yourself and be who God intended you to be, keep on shining. Keep on showing up as the person you are... shift the narrative to one that is empowering and in alignment with you and your dreams", Janet encourages.


Whether singing at mega-events or small hometown churches, Sacred Harmony ensures every performance is more than a concert; it's an anointed worship experience.
