The Revelation of the Mystery (Part 1 of 2)

Gabriel Swaggart

“For this cause I Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles, If ye have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which is given me to you-ward: How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words...)” - Ephesians 3:1-3

The third chapter of Ephesians concludes Paul's teaching on doctrinal issues relating to the church of Ephesus. After presenting the idea that those in the Ephesian church were no longer aliens but children of God, he begins a dissertation on his apostolic role and what the Holy Spirit had given him. He was given a mandate by the Spirit of God to explain the great mystery of joining both Jew and Gentile into one family. This was not exactly a welcoming thought to many, yet this was the will of God - creating a family consisting of both Jew and Gentile being joined together as one. In other words, those who are saved, as Paul presented in Ephesians 2:8-10, are a part of this new family.

A PRISONER OF JESUS CHRIST

At the time of this writing, Paul was confined to house arrest in Rome, not for something he did wrong but for being a Christian. This could have given him time to express his heart toward the church of Ephesus by presenting a letter of unity within the body of Christ, which was not being lived out. As a result, Paul begins this chapter with the express purpose of acknowledging himself, not as a prisoner of Caesar but of Jesus Christ. He chose to do this; he wanted to reiterate that he does not belong to Caesar but to Jesus Christ. Ultimately, Paul understands that this situation was the will of God for his life, and instead of complaining about his circumstance, he chose to believe God for his overall well-being. He believed that the God he served had total and complete care over his life. Therefore, he could call himself a prisoner of Jesus Christ.

Can we say the same about our own lives today? Do we believe that our God has total and complete care over our lives? Do we consider ourselves prisoners of Jesus Christ? Regardless of the circumstances you are in, nothing happens to the believer that takes God by surprise. Everything that happens to us is caused by God or allowed by God. Instead of asking why, what, or how, we should try having a different mindset - that God is trying to teach us something and that we have to be sensitive to the voice of the Holy Spirit to lead us through that specific situation.

A STEWARD OF THE GRACE OF GOD

Paul expresses the notion that he was given the responsibility of being a steward for the grace of God, which speaks of his divine mission to preach the Gospel to the Gentiles while at the same time being the one who was given

the meaning of the new covenant. It was the responsibility of the apostle to be the caretaker of this message, which would revolutionize the Christian world - the message of Jesus Christ and Him crucified. God had a plan from before the foundations of the world for His Son, Jesus Christ, to redeem humanity through the means of the cross. God also planned to bring both Jew and Gentile together as one body, forming the mystical body of Christ. Paul was chosen as a vessel to proclaim and explain the message of Christ and the cross to the Gentiles, that they could be saved and walk in victory according to their faith in the finished work of Christ, and that both Jew and Gentile are reconciled unto God through the simple act of faith into one body, one family.

This plan was not conjured up in Paul's mind, nor was it given to him through conversation with other people. This specific revelation was provided to him by the Holy Spirit. Looking back at his life, no one knew the Bible of that day better than Paul. Yet, he did not understand its true implications and what it actually meant. This would change on the Damascus road when Jesus revealed Himself to this Pharisee. After some time in what is known as the “silent years,” it is believed that the Holy Spirit began to unravel the great mystery of grace and God's redemption plan for the Gentile race.

GOD'S PLAN FOR THE CHURCH

At the heart of this plan is Jesus Christ. God's grand plan was made manifest in Christ through His work on Calvary's cross. Through His work, He would create a people, the Jews, combining them with outsiders (Gentiles) who had no chance to be reconciled unto God and bring them together to form a new body, which we now know as the church. The purpose of explaining this mystery concisely is to challenge the body of Christ in this way; we are not a body that is exclusive in nature but rather inclusive. Because of this, we are to treat our fellow Christians with kindness, love, respect, and grace. If the world's Savior has extended His mercy, grace, love, and compassion to us, how much more should we extend to those around us, including our Christian family? There is too much division within the body of Christ, and Paul's thesis in this short epistle is to explain the unity of the body through Christ.

Until this point, the purpose of the church was concealed from all until the Holy Spirit revealed it to Paul. He planned to include the Gentile race within the family of God and open it up to the world at large. Currently, the church is made up primarily of Gentiles, and we are thankful that this way has opened up to us. The Gospel of Jesus Christ was never meant for a particular group of people, but God's plan was always to open it up to the masses. Regarding the church as a whole,

most would understand that the church is not a building but a people. Those who are saved and belong to the family of God are, in fact, the church. And seeing that someone, somewhere, shared the Gospel with us, then we must, in turn, do the same, for there are hungry souls who need Jesus, and it is our responsibility to bring them the greatest story ever told, the story of Jesus Christ and Him crucified.

THE CROSS

Ultimately, the purpose of the church is to be God's hand extended, to bring the message of hope, peace, restoration, reconciliation, and salvation to those downtrodden and hurting. All of these are found in what Jesus Christ has done for us. The cross of Christ must ever be the heartbeat of the

church. When we leave the cross, we leave our purpose for existing. When we leave the cross, we turn our backs on what brought us into the family of God to begin with. When we leave the cross, we leave salvation. There is no purpose in presenting a Christless cross, for a Christless cross cannot save anyone, and neither can a Christless cross deliver anyone from the very bondage of sin. The cross must be our message, and it must be our way of life. As a whole, the body of Christ must return to the cross of Christ, and once it does, we will have a real story to tell, how Jesus Christ gave all, so that we can experience true salvation and deliverance from sin.



JENNIFER SIDES

There is Nothing Too Hard for God!

From East Texas, singer/songwriter Jennifer Sides fell in love with music at a young age. It was Country star Barbara Mandrell that nurtured Jennifer's love of music and became her first real influence. She would listen to her 8-track tapes and watch Barbara and the Mandrell Sisters on TV. Jennifer recalls, "As a young girl I was so impressed with Barbara because, not only could the lady sing, but she could also play eight different instruments, and she was an actress and an author."

Jennifer remembers writing songs in her bedroom as early as the age of six. By the age of fifteen she began writing poems. After she received the Lord as her Savior when she was twenty years old, she wrote her first Christian song that very day and has been writing ever since. By the age of 25 Jennifer was learning to play the guitar. With a little help, she put a song to music and played at a church a few days later.

Although every opportunity for Jennifer to share her talents fueled her dream of having a successful music ministry, she still felt it was out of reach and not the right timing. But that's when God turned a seemingly chance encounter into an amazing opportunity.

Jennifer had walked into a local music store that she had visited several times before. This time, however, the store owner approached her and said, "I hear you write songs," and mentioned that his son owned a recording studio. Soon after, Jennifer found herself in the studio, recording her very first album.

In June 2022, Jennifer landed a recording agreement with Canyon Creek Records, one of the music industry's most prominent Christian Country record labels. Immediately, the record company released what would be Jennifer's debut radio single, *Footsteps of My King*. Almost instantly, the song began to climb various national music charts (and still climbing) including Cross Country USA Hot 100, Cashbox Magazine's Christian Country Top 100, and Christian Voice Magazine's Country Gospel Top 100 – where it currently sits at #37. It's official – *Footsteps of My King* is a Top 40 hit!

Jennifer is currently in the studio finishing up her seventh recording to date and is expected to release in April.

When Jennifer stands before an audience, she loves to sing her songs and share stories of how each song came to birth and how they all relate to scripture. She is also transparent with her own struggles and loves to share her testimony. She says, "I want to be real with the struggles I have faced and not wear a mask or be fake." Her mission is to encourage believers and non-believers alike in a way that they are drawn closer to the Lord, to plant seeds or water seeds that others have planted before her.

Perhaps, one of her greatest challenges was overcoming debilitating anxiety. This was a very real struggle that lasted for many years. "There was a time in my life I couldn't even go to church unless someone was with me."

During this long battle, Jennifer did not sing in public for thirteen years until, one day, someone told her that Satan was trying to steal her voice. She says this was the "wake-up call" she needed to help her overcome and, with God's help, she became more than a conqueror. Not only did she begin singing again, but, she says, "The floodgates to songwriting were opened like never before. And it's not just about singing, but the encouragement offered in the words I speak to my audience."

She continues, "The most rewarding thing to me about all of this is how people respond to me after I speak and sing at an event. When I hear how my ministry has touched and encouraged them it reminds me that this is really what it's all about."

Jennifer is a member of the Inspirational Country Music Association, International Country Gospel Music Association, Texoma Gospel Music Association, and the International Cowboy Church Alliance Network. She is also affiliated with the Texas Hill Country Gospel Jubilee.

The Power of the Spoken Word

We must learn to speak the word of God. Proverbs 18:21 declares, "Death and life are in the power of the tongue."

We know that the Word of God is life, Proverbs 4:20-22 says, "My son give attention to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes; keep them in the midst of your heart; for they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh."


When we speak that which is not of faith, or does not agree with the Word of God we are really sinning and calling God a liar.

David is the brother Leah asked for, prompting the family to travel all the way to Russia to bring him home at sixteen months of age. He graduated high school in May of 2022 and continues to progress on the mandolin, upright bass, trumpet, and fiddle.

2008 brought change to David Sawyer and his family as he was worship leader at church and began to feel the draw to spread music with his entire family. He resigned as worship leader and began to take his family band from church to church. Their first invitation was to a Cowboy Church in the Fort Worth Stockyards, and this led to their nationwide travels.

2021 would bring a new project, "A Better Place," and their very first radio release entitled, *Where Could I Go?* Now charting is another release from the project entitled, *Ain't No Grave*. In addition to radio Simple Gifts (The Sawyer Family Band) has a television show, "The Simple Gifts Show" with 26 episodes recorded. It can be viewed on the band website or on demand at UANETWORK.TV. The band also had the privilege of performing for Gold Star Families flown into Texas from all over the country for the Wild West Show in their hometown of Weatherford, Texas.


When the pandemic started it presented a lot of challenges to groups and ministries, including this family. "What do you do when you make your living gathering together and people can no longer gather? But God also supplied our need, brought us work, and gave us time together as a family."

2021 would also bring a new meaning to their second release, *Ain't No Grave* as Kathy was diagnosed with stage four ovarian cancer. Treatment has been difficult, but as David describes, "The Lord has shown Himself in so many ways. The doctors allowed chemo on Mondays with the hope Kathy could sing over the weekends. She did not miss an opportunity that was within three hours of home. Even without traditional insurance, astronomical bills have been paid. The power of prayer has become such a real thing as the saints have lifted the family up day after day. Though the battle continues, Kathy feels healthy and is now able to participate fully in the family schedule."

Success is an understatement when it comes to the awards this family band has achieved. Too numerous to list them all, here are just a few highlights: Inspirational Country Music Association's 'Bluegrass Band of the Year,' Two-time recipient of the International Western Music Association 'Group Harmony Award,' World Fiddling Champion – Junior Division (Leah), Texas State Fiddle Champion - Freshman Division (Leah), Academy of Western Artists 'Young Artist Award' (David, son), International Western Music Association 'Crescendo (Rising Star) Award' (David, son), International Western Music Association 'Male Yodeler of the Year' (David, dad), and Indiana State Fair Old Time Fiddler Champion (David, dad).

People are uplifted by seeing a family who loves the Lord using all their musical gifts to create a fully live, worshipful experience. During an event with Simple Gifts (The Sawyer Family Band) attendees will enjoy a mixture of old hymns, along with their own take on praise and worship and many original tunes.



ENJOYING EVERYDAY LIFE

The Folly of Fickle Feelings

Joyce Meyer

There are some people in this world who are extremely reliable. You can count on them for just about anything and somehow, they'll always come through. However, I've found that many people are not very reliable.

Maybe you know someone who is a nice person, but if you ask them to do something, you're just not sure if they're going to follow through. In other words, they're unreliable.

I've discovered that feelings are a lot like unreliable people - we can't depend on them to be what we want or need them to be all the time. Not only that, they aren't necessarily interested in what's best for us. And they always want to have their way.

Feelings get us excited about going shopping when we really don't have any money to spend. They entice us to eat cheesecake when we're trying to avoid extra calories and lead us to stay up late working or watching TV when we need to get up early the next day. Then after the damage is done, we have to deal with the consequences.

Our feelings are fickle - they change like the wind. Yet it's amazing how much we let them have their way in our lives. But as believers in Christ, we have something much better and more dependable to follow than our feelings and that's the Word of God.

Conquering Confusion with the Truth

When we feel strongly about something in our heart, it's not always easy for us to determine whether or not we're really in agreement with God (see Jeremiah 17:9). Thankfully, God's Word doesn't leave us lost in confusion.

Hebrews 4:12 says that the Word of God is "sharper than any two-edged sword...exposing and judging the very thoughts and intentions of the heart" (AMP).

So, if we really want to rise above our feelings, we must let the Word of God be the final deciding factor in our decisions. There will be times when we can't find a verse for the specific issue we're dealing with. But we can always pray and ask God for wisdom (see James 1:5).

In the meantime, we need to trust Him, be patient and keep on praying. Remember that God is always available to help us live beyond our feelings and do what pleases Him.

Set Your Mind to Do What's Right

The first step toward managing our emotions is found in Colossians 3:2. It says, "Set your mind and keep focused habitually on the things above...not on things that are on the earth..."

There are many things in this world that could easily affect our minds and emotions and we need to learn how to rise above them all. When negative thoughts are building up

and trying to take control of your emotions, take a few minutes to set your mind on God and His Word.

It also helps to speak positively about whatever is bothering you. Here are a few examples to give you an idea of what I'm talking about: "My family may not be everything I'd like them to be, but I am thankful I have a family. My house is not as nice as I would like it to be, but it's still a nice place to live. I don't see how I'm going to get through this painful situation, but Jesus is with me and He will help me overcome it!"

How to Win a Spiritual Tug-of-War

Sometimes we want to ask God to instantly change our circumstances when we're struggling. But the truth is until we learn to be content in every situation we face, we will continue to be tested.

Jeremiah 17:10 says, "I, the Lord, search and examine the mind, I test the heart, to give to each man according to his ways, according to the results of his deeds."

There are a few different "buttons" the devil knows he can push to get an emotional reaction out of me, so I make a point to prepare myself before that happens with the Word. I love Psalm 94:12-13. It says, "Blessed [with wisdom and prosperity] is the man whom You discipline and instruct, O Lord, and whom You teach from Your law, that You may grant him [power to calm himself and find] peace in the days of adversity..."

You see, the more we discipline ourselves to say no to our feelings and yes to the wisdom of God, the easier it becomes to defeat them in a spiritual tug-of-war. I want to encourage you to consistently take time to focus on what the Bible says. It will empower you to control those unreliable emotions and do what is best for you!





Rich Mullins Never-Before-Heard Live Recording 'Deep Valley' Is Now Available

The latest recording in commemoration of the 25th anniversary of the untimely passing of American songwriter and Gospel music icon Rich Mullins is out now. "Deep Valley," Mullins' first-ever live recording to be made available to the public, is out now on Old Bear Records. "Deep Valley" arrives on the heels of "Bellsburg: The Songs of Rich Mullins" (Old Bear Records), a various artists tribute album from last fall that landed at No. 1 on the iTunes Christian charts.

Uncovered from a stack of unreleased recordings, "Deep Valley" features 21 live tracks, which include five bonus songs and some of his most time-tested tunes like *Sing Your Praise to the Lord* and *Elijah*. Also included is a batch of Mullins' never-before-heard songs interspersed with his infamous ragamuffin stories. The album was recorded at Deep Valley Christian Camp in Slippery Rock, Pennsylvania, in 1984, at the outset of his storied music career.

"Deep Valley" represents a kind of bridge between his early years as a songwriter and his later years as a recording artist. Some of these songs may be familiar; some will be completely 'new' to you. Some are Richard's alone; some were made popular by other artists such as Amy Grant, Debby Boone, and Caedmon's Call. I hope you will find joy in listening to Deep Valley as you step back into this music from a lesser-known time in Richard's life," states Beth Snell Lutz, the album's primary Executive Producer and one

of Mullins' long-time friends as well as the keeper of Rich Mullins Early Music, an archive of Mullins' earliest unreleased catalog.

"During his storied lifetime, and now 25 years after his tragic death, Rich's words, not just his songs, resonate deep within our minds and our hearts," shares Andrew Greer, Co-Executive Producer of "Deep Valley" along with Lutz, Old Bear Records' Anthony Hoisington, and Dave Trout of UTR Media, while both Chris Marchand and Joe Cook are Assistant Producers.







Remembering...

Billy Wayne Holcomb • Gerald (“Jerry”) Kirksey

Jerry Kirksey

June 13, 1940 – January 25, 2023

Born in Panama City, Florida, on June 13, 1940, Gerald (“Jerry”) Walter Kirksey and his family returned to his parents’ hometown of Pensacola following World War II. It was during his junior year of high school that Jerry first began working in one of his greatest passions, radio. After his graduation as a part of the Class of 1958, Jerry moved back to Panama City to begin work with WTHR Radio.

A return to Pensacola in March of 1960 set Jerry on the path that would ultimately define his professional career. He began working with The Florida Boys as the quartet’s promotional director and office manager. This led to a working relationship with J.G. Whitfield. Jerry would work closely with Mr. Whitfield as the Southern Gospel music icon promoted concerts across the nation, and eventually launch what went on to become the largest and oldest Southern Gospel music publication, *Singing News Magazine*.

Jerry served with *Singing News Magazine* from May 1969 until his retirement in 2010, encompassing a total of 492 issues. During his time at the magazine, Jerry created Southern Gospel music’s first National Radio Airplay Chart (1970) and the *Singing News Fan Awards* (1971).

In addition to his work with *Singing News*, Jerry served on the board of directors of the original Gospel Music Association, and the board of the original Southern Gospel Music Association of Georgia. He was involved in organizing

the Southern Gospel Music Guild and the modern-day Southern Gospel Music Association. He was actively involved in the building and development of the original SGMA Hall of Fame and Museum at Dollywood. Jerry was inducted into the SGMA Hall of Fame in 2011.

Jerry married Carolyn Sue Rhodes on October 1, 1967. Sons Kenneth and Brett would eventually work with Jerry at *Singing News*, especially after the family moved to Boone, North Carolina in 1987, following the sale of the publication to North Carolina businessman Maurice Templeton. Likewise, Carolyn was a fixture at many Southern Gospel concerts as she and Jerry represented *Singing News* across the nation. Carolyn passed away in July of 2015.

Jerry Kirksey, Editor Emeritus of *Singing News Magazine*, passed away January 25, 2023, at the age of 82. Mr. Kirksey had been in declining health for several years.



Dr. Billy Wayne Holcomb

February 8, 1938 – January 8, 2023

Billy Wayne Holcomb was born February 8, 1938, in Ubell Fannin County, Texas in the home of his grandmother. He lived in Honey Grove until November 1944, when his family moved to Denison, Texas.

As a young boy his mother asked, “Billy Wayne, what do you want to do when you grow up?” He replied, “I want to write songs and sing them.” She told him, “If the Lord wants you to, he will educate you.”

Though he never had formal training Billy played piano in an amazing way. He also played the guitar, accordion, and organ. He began writing songs and singing in high school, originally playing with a Western Gospel Band.

He graduated in 1956 and went on to University of Texas Permian Basin College in Odessa, Texas. He studied theology in Cleveland, Tennessee and received his Doctor of Music degree from Emmanuel Baptist University in North Carolina.

On June 30th, 1956, Billy married Mildred Christine Pate in Paris, Texas. Billy gave his beautiful bride the nickname, "Milly the model," and it has become her name to many friends and family.

It was also in 1956 that Billy, along with W. Lindsey Thompson, co-founded the International Country Gospel Music Association. This organization is still going strong today under the current President, Dan Duncan. In 1977, he founded the Texoma Gospel Music Association, which promotes local musicians and is still going strong under the current President, Dr. Mary Fay Jackson.

Billy worked for different department stores for some time. He was later called to preach and served as Pastor of The Church of God of Prophecy in Pittsburg, Texas.

Billy wrote more than 1000 songs, many recorded himself and several by top stars. Most of his songs were Country Gospel, Patriotic, and some Country. He was in Billboard Music Magazine Top 100 in the late 1960s. He continued to write and record songs, poems, and books. At the time of his death, he had several other projects in the works.

Dr. Holcomb was a collector of Western memorabilia. In 1942, at the age of four, Billy's mother took him to a Gene Autry movie. He could never remember anything about meeting Gene, but he kept his autograph from that day. From then on, Gene was his Hero. He began to collect everything he could find about Gene and Champion. He had hundreds of magazines, posters, coloring books, everything about his #1 hero. He also had devoted collections to Roy Rogers, Allan "Rocky" Lane, Randolph Scott, and many of the other movie cowboys. He collected everything, and even as a youngster of eight he had the discipline and foresight to take care of his treasures. He often bought several copies of magazines or comic books and TV guides. What was fading nostalgia for most was always still bright for him. It was all stored in that unbelievable memory of his.

Billy and Mildred were married for 66 blissful years. The couple stood strong together through life's joys and hardships. They were parents to two daughters – Kim and Denise. They had six grandchildren and eight great grandchildren. Dr Billy Wayne Holcomb went home to be with his Lord and Savior early Sunday morning, January 8, 2023. He was at home surrounded by his loving family.







Pro-lifers defeat 'censorship zone' but much bigger one in the works

Two criminal cases in Great Britain drew fresh attention to that nation's sad dystopian-like culture and legal environment, but both cases have a happy ending for the pro-life activists who were arrested and charged but demanded their right to free speech.

In two separate incidents, a priest named Sean Gough and pro-life leader Isabel Vaughan-Spruce were charged in December with violating a Public Spaces Protection Order in the city of Birmingham. An abortion clinic there is protected from protesters who call the area around it a "censorship zone" due to the city law.

Although the criminal charges against Gough and Vaughan-Spruce were dropped for lack of evidence, or more likely due to public outcry, Catholic News Agency reports both pro-life activists demanded a formal court acquittal so prosecutors could not charge them later.

In mid February, a Magistrates Court found both of them not guilty even though both defendants were located inside the Public Spaces zone.

The two defendants were represented by Alliance Defending Freedom International.

Outside the courtroom, ADF International attorney Jeremiah Iggunbole told reporters the defendants were justly acquitted but he pointed out the British parliament is debating a national law that would create more criminals beyond Birmingham.

A press release, signed by numerous abortion rights groups, demands "national buffer zones" that block the harassment of women entering the abortion clinic. Praying outside the clinics and singing hymns are listed as examples of harassment, according to the abortion groups.

"How did we get to the place," the ADF attorney asked, "where freedom of thought, which is an absolute right, is investigated and put on trial?"

'Are you praying?'

Just how Orwellian is the Birmingham law?

In a two-minute encounter that was recorded, Vaughan-Spruce was standing across the street from the abortion clinic

when police officers approached her and demanded to know if she was protesting, which would violate the law.

"What are you here for today?" a police officer demands to know. "Physically, I'm just standing here," Vaughan-Spruce, hands in her pockets, replies. "Why here of all places?" the officer says. "I know you don't live nearby."

Vaughan-Spruce then points out there is an abortion clinic across the street but says "no" when the officer asks if she is protesting. "Are you praying?" the police officer asks, since that violates the city law. "I might be praying in my head," she replies.

Father Gough fought the ordinance more openly: He was holding a sign reading "Praying for Free Speech" when police arrested him Dec. 9.

According to the CNA story, Birmingham police also charged the priest with a crime because of a pro-life bumper sticker on his automobile that was parked inside the zone.

"I stand by my beliefs: unborn lives do matter," Gough said outside the courtroom. "But whatever your views are on abortion, we can all agree that a democratic country cannot be in the business of prosecuting thought crimes."

America back on track," explains Dans, who is serving as the project's director.

He acknowledges, though, that the enemy is a formidable one, saying, "We are against very powerful forces, dark forces to be sure."

"We are up against basically game over in 2024 for this country in terms of really getting us righted," Dans submits, adding that the 2025 Presidential Transition Project believes "we have two years and one chance to get things right."

'Balloon-gate' reveals America's feeble leadership, says Bauer

A conservative activist says America's military leaders need to understand that any future war between China and the United States will be a no-holds-barred conflict because Beijing is an "officially godless regime."

On Thursday, February 16, President Joe Biden broke his silence on the shoot-down of three aerial objects in early February. He told the press those objects were like no more than "benign objects" that were launched by private companies or research institutions.

But there continues to be growing concerns about his administration's handling of the first balloon that was spotted in American airspace (above Montana) on January 31, tracked for several days by the media and the public as it traversed across the country, then finally shot down on February 4 off the coast of South Carolina. Several news outlets now report that U.S. intelligence agencies were watching the balloon from the time it lifted off from its home base in China, but did nothing until it had completed its trek across the U.S.

During an appearance on American Family Radio, Gary Bauer of the Campaign for Working Families said he doesn't believe the current leadership in the White House has the will, the strength, or the understanding to protect the country if forced into a high-stakes war with China.

"A war with Communist China will determine which nation rules the world, in a sense," he stated. "And experts are telling us, if we'll listen, that we're likely to lose a couple of aircraft carriers within the first week of the war – with each one of those aircraft carriers having 5,000 young men and women on them. Is the United States ready for that?"

And Bauer warned America's military leaders better understand that the next war will not be fought by the rules it has been holding itself to in recent years.

"If the Communist Chinese get into a war with the United States, nothing will restrain them – nothing! Absolutely nothing!

They're an officially godless regime," he exclaimed. "This would be a serious war with a serious nation that believes with all its heart and soul that the future belongs to them."

As AFN reported earlier, a four-star U.S. Air Force general is predicting war with China by 2025 over an invasion of Taiwan. The memo from General Mike Minihan was intended for officers of the Air Mobility Command, which provides transport and refueling support around the globe, but the general's urgent warning to improve airmen training was leaked to the public.

Pharmacy chains hear plea to ignore abortion-defending Biden admin

Concerns continue to be raised over major pharmacy chains that are ignoring huge moral, legal, and safety issues by offering abortion-inducing drugs to pregnant women.

CVS, Rite Aid and Walgreens are in the cross-hairs for stocking chemical abortion drugs mifepristone and misoprostal after the abortion-supporting U.S. Justice Department said doing so does not violate the Comstock Act.

One of the organizations urging the pharmacies to reconsider is the Family Research Council, where Joy Stockbauer is a policy analyst at the Center for Human Dignity.

"First and foremost, we know that abortion takes the life of an innocent human being," she says. "And we do not believe that retail pharmacies, who are supposed to be in the business of healing people and ending illness, and curing suffering, should take themselves into the business of intentionally ending the lives of unborn children."

Family Research Council has signed its name to a letter pleading with the pharmacy chains to stop acting as "de-facto abortion centers" by dispensing abortion-inducing drugs.

Last month, Republican attorneys general from 20 states fired off a letter to executives at Walgreens and CVS warning them distributing the abortion pills through the mail is "both unsafe and illegal."

The letter mentions the Comstock Act and insists the pharmacy chains are taking action based on the opinion of the Biden administration. "We reject the Biden administration's bizarre interpretation, and we expect courts will as well," the letter states.

According to Stockbauer, beyond the emotional trauma women experience after killing the fetus, the abortion drugs have been proven to be more dangerous than in-clinic surgical abortions.

"So there's both a physical element and a psychological and emotional element," she warns, "both of which the abortion industry is lying to women about."





Cheesy Chicken and Yellow Rice Casserole

- 2-3 boneless chicken breasts
- 1 onion (chopped)
- 1 colored bell pepper (chopped)
- 1 package yellow rice
- 1-2 teaspoons of chicken bouillon crystals
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- Water

Cheese Sauce

- 4 tablespoons butter (melted)
- 4 tablespoons flour
- 2 cups milk
- 1 cup cheddar cheese (grated)
- Salt and pepper to taste



Boil chicken breasts in enough water to cover and add bouillon crystals. Cook until done. Remove chicken from broth (reserve broth). Cut chicken into bitesize pieces and place in 9x13 casserole dish.

Add rice, onion, bell pepper, and garlic powder to broth. Cook until done watching closely to add more water and if necessary.

Meanwhile, on medium heat melt butter in medium size pot. Add flour and whisk. Add milk. Turn heat to low, whisking constantly to desired thickness. Add cheese and whisk until melted.

Combine chicken and rice. Stir in 3/4 cheese sauce and top with remaining 1/4. Bake at 350° until hot and bubbly for about 20 minutes.

Tender Flat Iron Steak for Two


- 1/2 lb. flat iron steak
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 2 cloves garlic (minces)
- 1 teaspoon dried parsley
- 1/4 teaspoon dried rosemary
- 1/2 teaspoon dried chives
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 3/4 teaspoon pepper
- 1/4 teaspoon dry mustard
- 1/4 cup broth or water with beef bouillon




Mix oil, broth and spices together in a Ziplock baggy. Add steak. Seal pressing as much air out of the bag as possible. Marinate in the refrigerator for at least 2 hours.

Heat a cast iron skillet over medium high heat. Cook the steak in the hot skillet for 3-6 minutes on each side to the desired doneness. Add a small amount of water if the skillet starts drying out. Pour over meat to serve.







“For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.” (Matthew 24:21)

7. Open Borders – Closed Minds







Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth forever. Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time. (1 John 2:15-18)

We read in Genesis 1 that God created the world and everything in it including man in His own image. "And God saw everything He had made, and, behold it was very good." (Genesis 1:31)
