



CROSSFIRE

The Bridegroom Cometh, Go Ye Out to Meet Him (Part 2)

“While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept. And at midnight, there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet Him.” - MATTHEW 25:5-6

As Christ continues this all-important narrative, it is now midnight. However, when he speaks of midnight, He is not actually speaking of the time of day, but rather that we are living in the last of the last days. I want to focus on the fact that we are not told in Scripture when the Lord is going to come back, and because of that, we must live our lives as being ready for that momentous event to take place at any time. Of what momentous occasion are we speaking? We are, of course, speaking of the rapture of the church. I want to take this time to answer some questions about the rapture of the church that some of you may have.

WHEN WILL THE RAPTURE TAKE PLACE?

The first question that I want to answer is regarding when the rapture of the church will take place. According to our text, and several others that we will refer to, we do not know when the rapture will take place, but one thing we do know is that it could take place at any moment. Jesus said in Matthew 24:36, “But of that day and hour knows no man, no, not the angels in heaven, but My Father only.” We have heard from many individuals peddling the idea that they have decoded some secret message throughout the pages of the Bible that will guarantee the exact date of the rapture, but all have been proven wrong. The above Scripture tells us that NO ONE knows when this event will take place. So, when you hear someone proclaiming that he knows when the rapture will take place, do not believe him.

I can tell everyone one thing about the rapture, and that is that it will take place. Seeing that major events take place every 1,000 to 2,000 years, we know that this day is drawing nigh. And seeing that we don’t know when the rapture will take place, we should live our lives as prepared as we possibly can.

WHAT ARE THE QUALIFICATIONS OF BEING INCLUDED IN THE RAPTURE?

This next question is one that has been asked by many throughout the years, and the answer is very simple. The only qualification to be included in the rapture is to be saved or, in other words, born again. This means to accept Christ as one’s personal Lord and Savior, to be washed in the blood

of the Lamb, to believe that Jesus Christ died and rose again, and He is now seated by the right hand of the Father.

To make a few people unhappy with my statement, this means that you do not need to speak in tongues to be saved and to make it to heaven. I understand that there are some who believe that in order to be saved, the individual in question needs to speak in tongues, but that is a wrong belief system. There is nothing in Scripture that says that one has to speak in tongues in order to be saved. Nothing! However, I do want to make one thing very clear - I believe in the baptism with the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking with other tongues, but one does not need that in order to make the rapture or to make heaven his home. The baptism with the Holy Spirit is for service, meaning that we need the infilling of the Holy Spirit to live this life here on earth. As someone has said, “We don’t need the Holy Spirit to get to heaven, but we need the Holy Spirit to go to Wal-Mart.”

WITHOUT THE BAPTISM WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT, LITTLE CAN BE DONE FOR GOD

I understand that some may disagree with this next statement, but I believe it to be scriptural. Without the power of the Holy Spirit, and I speak of one being filled with the Spirit, there is little that can be done for God on this earth. This is why it was an imperative statement made by Christ in Acts 1, that every single disciple (Christian) needs to be filled with the Holy Spirit and speak with tongues.

I have had many Christians try and argue this point by bringing up individuals who have done a great work for Christ without being filled with the Spirit. My answer to them has always been the same - they walked in the light that they knew, and God honored such. However, we have been given much more light, and being filled with the Spirit is a part of that light. If we reject what God has provided, there is not much that He can do within our hearts and lives.


WATER BAPTISM

Along with this thought, there are some who believe that we need to be water baptized in order to be saved. Once again, this is an erroneous belief. What are we to do with the dying thief who hung next to Christ and died believing that Christ

was, and is, the Messiah? He did not have time to be water baptized, and neither was he filled with the Spirit, but yet, Christ told him that he would be welcomed into paradise. Think of this: when that dying thief went down with Christ to paradise, he didn't stay for long because when Christ led captivity captive and brought the old covenant believers to heaven, he was one of them. That man is in heaven right now all because he believed.

Water baptism is simply an outward sign of what has already happened on the inside of the individual. Water does not, and cannot, save anyone. There are many who believe that one has to be baptized in water to be saved, but once again, that is not scriptural. I once heard a famous Country music singer make the statement when asked when he accepted Christ, that he was baptized in water at a young age, and because of that, he was good to go. Notice that he never made a profession of faith, or that once he said yes to Christ, he knew that he had been changed. The only thing he said was that he was baptized in water. Am I saying that this famous Country music singer is not saved? No, because I don't know his heart. What I am saying is that if that person, or anyone, places his faith in the act of water baptism and not in Christ, then all that happened was a ceremony.

Faith in Christ and the cross is the only requirement to be saved, and as such, is the only requirement to be qualified for



the rapture. If you are truly born again, then you are a candidate for heaven. In the meantime, while we are waiting, we must be vigilant in what God has given us. We never know when that day will come when He will call us home, whether in death or by the rapture. We see from our text that when the bridegroom came, there were five virgins who were not ready, and neither were they looking for Him.

Remembering...

RICHARD SMALLWOOD - RON KENOLY



Richard Smallwood

November 30, 1948 – January 25, 2026

Born November 30, 1948, Richard Smallwood entered the world with a gift that would one day reshape the sound of worship across generations. Long before choirs lifted their hands to his music, long before *Total Praise* became a global anthem, there was simply a young boy in Washington, D.C., sitting at a piano and discovering that God had placed something extraordinary in him.

Smallwood didn't just compose songs - he constructed cathedrals of sound. His classical training, blended with the soul of Black Gospel tradition, created a musical language that felt both ancient and new. Every chord carried intention. Every lyric carried weight. And every song carried the unmistakable imprint of a man who knew what it meant to seek God with his whole heart.

His music became a refuge for the broken, a celebration for the joyful, and a steady companion for believers walking through the valleys of life. *Center of My Joy*, *I Love the Lord*, *Anthem of Praise*, and of course, *Total Praise* - these weren't just compositions. They were lifelines. They were prayers set to melody. They were sermons wrapped in harmony.

What made Smallwood remarkable wasn't only his brilliance, though he had plenty of it. It was his vulnerability. He wrote from the deep places - grief, hope, longing, faith - and he invited the Church to be honest before God. His transparency about mental health and personal struggle gave

permission for others to breathe, to heal, to believe that worship could rise even from the ashes.

He carried himself with a quiet dignity, a gentle spirit, and a reverence for God that shaped every stage he stepped onto. Choir directors studied him. Musicians revered him. Worshipers felt seen by him. And through it all, he remained a servant - never chasing fame, only chasing the presence of the One who inspired every note.

The world learned he had passed away on January 25, 2026, leaving behind a legacy that feels almost immeasurable. His departure created a hush across the gospel community - not the silence of despair, but the reverent quiet that follows a life well lived.

Richard Smallwood has simply gone where his music always pointed: into the presence of the Lord he adored.

And the Church, forever shaped by his gift, simply whispers back the words he taught us to sing: "*You are the source of my strength... You are the strength of my life.*"



Ron Kenoly

December 6, 1944 – February 3, 2026

Born December 6, 1944, in Coffeyville, Kansas, Ron Kenoly's his life became a living testimony of joy, humility, and unwavering devotion to leading God's people into authentic worship.

From his earliest years, music was woven into his identity. After graduating high school, he served in the United States Air Force from 1965 to 1968, performing with the band The Mellow Fellows - a season that sharpened his musical gifts and introduced him to audiences across military bases.

But it was his return to Christ in the 1970s that redirected his path from secular stages to sacred spaces, setting the course for a ministry that would impact the world.

His breakthrough came in the early 1990s with Integrity Music, where albums like "Lift Him Up" (1992), "God Is Able" (1994), and "Welcome Home" (1996) reshaped the sound of congregational worship. "Lift Him Up" became the fastest-selling worship album of its time, and songs such as *Ancient of Days*, *Jesus Is Alive*, and *Be Glorified* became global anthems still sung today.

Kenoly's ministry was marked not only by musical excellence but by theological depth. He often reminded worship teams that "worship begins long before the first note is played," teaching that true worship flows from gratitude, obedience, and a life surrendered to Christ. His longtime music director, Bruno Miranda, described him as a man of "integrity, humility, and reverence," whose leadership shaped generations of worshippers. "He was never an artist, never an entertainer. He was a worship leader."

Throughout his five-decade career, Ron Kenoly traveled the world, leading worship gatherings, mentoring worship leaders, and bringing a contagious joy to every platform he touched. His ministry resonated especially strongly across Africa, where he became a beloved figure at major worship events and inspired countless psalmists.

Dr. Ron Kenoly, one of the most influential voices in modern praise and worship, stepped into glory on February 3, 2026, at the age of 81.

Ron Kenoly's passing marks the end of an era, but his voice continues to echo in sanctuaries around the world. His songs remain a soundtrack of praise for millions, and his life stands as a reminder that worship is not performance - it is surrender.

Well done, good and faithful servant.





MARGIE'S MEDITATION

Fellowship with God

The Greek word for fellowship in the Bible is *koinonia*. This term signifies communion, partnership, and sharing in common.

Genesis 1: 27 states, "So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them."

What was God's purpose in creating humanity? He wanted to have fellowship with man. God came to the garden in the cool of the day and walked and talked and spent time with Adam and Eve. Sin broke man's fellowship with God, but God's desire to fellowship with man did not change. God set in motion to design a place whereby man could have fellowship with him through the redemption plan.

The Trinity Heirs

35 Years of Faith, Family, and a Calling that Still Echoes

Some ministries are built on talent. Others are built on opportunity. But The Trinity Heirs - rooted in Richmond, Kentucky - were built on something far stronger: a calling that refused to let them go.

Long before their voices blended in harmony, Ronnie Sparks, his wife, Beverly Holman Sparks, and her brother, Dale Holman, were simply three children raised in Christian homes where church wasn't optional - it was a way of life. "We were well accustomed to going to church when we were very young," they share. But it wasn't until later in life that each of them fully surrendered their hearts to Jesus, rededicated their lives, and became grounded in the work of their local church.

That deeper commitment would become the foundation of a ministry that has now touched lives for more than three decades.

Their love for music was born in those early church pews, where hymns and harmony were as familiar as family. In 1988, Ronnie and Beverly joined a singing ministry called The Lord's Servants after being invited by cousins. It was a season of growth, but by 1990, they felt God tugging them in a different direction. They stepped away, unsure of what was next, but certain that obedience mattered more than comfort.

That same year, God began to weave together something new. Ronnie, Beverly, and Dale accepted the call to form a Southern Gospel ministry that would become known as The Trinity Heirs. The name reflected their identity: heirs of God, joint-heirs with Christ, and servants committed to lifting up His name.

Their son, Brian Sparks, soon became an integral part of the ministry. Born with a severe birth injury that resulted in lifelong disabilities, including cerebral palsy, Brian's life has become one of the group's most powerful testimonies. His perseverance, joy, and unwavering faith have inspired countless hearts. He sings for Jesus while looking forward to the day Scripture promises - when his body will be made new.

Over the years, The Trinity Heirs have experienced unforgettable opportunities: singing on cruises, appearing on radio and television programs, participating in promotional showcases, and even flying to California to minister in song. They recorded with the Eddie Crook Company/Morning Star Records and saw multiple songs chart nationally.

But ask them what mattered most, and their answer is immediate and unchanging: souls. They say their most meaningful moments are "those in which souls were saved, touched, or helped by God working through us... it's all about Him." For The Trinity Heirs, ministry has never been about applause - it has always been about impact.

Like every long-standing ministry, their journey has included valleys as well as mountaintops. After sixteen years, Dale stepped away due to ongoing health issues. Ronnie and Beverly pressed on without replacing him, trusting the God who had called them.

Seven years later, their dear friend Barbara Jean Smith joined them in singing, and her husband Danny stepped in to help with sound, bookings, and anything else needed. Their partnership lasted until 2021, when Barbara and Danny launched a solo ministry. Once again, Ronnie and Beverly continued forward - faithful, steady, and convinced that calling doesn't guarantee ease, but it does guarantee purpose.

"We claim that calling doesn't make ministry easy," they say, "but souls saved or helped make it worth it."

Though they have never pursued awards, The Trinity Heirs have been honored repeatedly. They have received numerous Top 10 nominations in the Christian Voice Magazine Gospel Music Fan Awards in both Southern Gospel and Country Gospel categories. Their songs have charted consistently in Christian Voice Magazine's Southern Gospel Top 100, Cashbox Magazine's Southern Gospel Top 100, and Pure Gospel Radio's Top 40.

On November 9, 2025, a deeply meaningful moment occurred when Brian received the Shepherd's Heart Award from the Steven E. Dailey Evangelistic Association. Dr. Steven Dailey presented it "for an exemplary life of quiet strength, unwavering faith, and the profound inspiration that you provide for the total Body of Christ." It was a recognition not of performance, but of character - something the Sparks family values above all.

Songwriting has always been central to The Trinity Heirs' identity. Beverly and Dale penned most of the group's recorded material, with Brian contributing as well. Dale, also a preacher, continued to minister in word and song even after leaving the group. He later founded Living Waters Sanctuary in Berea, Kentucky, where he pastored faithfully until his passing on November 3, 2018. Ronnie and Beverly continue to honor his legacy by recording and releasing several of his songs.



Their latest CD, "Glory In The Sky," has produced multiple radio releases through Millennium Music Group. *Rescue The Perishing* peaked at #28 on the CVM Southern Gospel Top 100 and #26 on the Cashbox Southern Gospel Top 100. Most recently, *At Calvary* released through Millennium Music Group and *Will They See Jesus In Me?* released through Pure Gospel Promotions. Earlier Pure Gospel Promotions successes include *Hallelujah*, *I Have*

Made Myself Ready (#17) and *Hide It, Cover It, Blame It* (#5). All were written by Beverly Holman Sparks Music/BMI.

Listeners often describe Beverly's writing as "story songs," "message songs," and songs with "meat" in them - lyrics that challenge, comfort, and convict. Their vocals have been called "unique" and "anointed," a combination that has become their signature.

Even after accepting their call to music ministry, Ronnie and Beverly sought confirmation from God. That confirmation came when Beverly received a vivid dream affirming their direction. For more than thirty-five years, they have held tightly to that calling.

"We pray our heartfelt, original songs will challenge, encourage and inspire you," Beverly says. "Cause you to smile or cry tears of comfort and joy; and make an eternal difference in your life."

Their mission remains unchanged: to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ through songs and testimonies, to point the lost to Jesus, and to strengthen the body of Christ.

As they put it so simply and beautifully: "We don't want to just talk and sing about the love of God... we want to show it."

And after thirty-five years of faithfulness, it's clear - they already have.



ENJOYING EVERYDAY LIFE

The Reality of Being More than a Conqueror in Life

Joyce Meyer

Romans 8:37 (NIV) says, "...In all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us." But do we really know what it means to be more than a conqueror? I know it took many years for me to learn what it means and how to live the victorious life Jesus died to give us as believers.

I remember many years when I went to church faithfully every week, yet my private life was pathetic. It was so frustrating because I really loved God and was a born-again believer, but I wasn't experiencing victory over the problems in my life so that I could really live for God and help people.

As I eventually grew in my personal relationship with Jesus and spent time studying the Word, I came to understand what it means to be more than a conqueror and how I could get there. And if I can do it, so can you.

To be more than a conqueror means that before you ever get a problem, you already know that whatever problem comes your way, you can overcome it through Christ! You live with confidence that God loves you no matter what and He will never leave you nor forsake you. And when you have this kind of relationship with God, you aren't constantly afraid of bad news or of things that may happen that aren't in your plan. When the unexpected happens or you're disappointed, you won't be devastated by it.

See, when you truly understand who you are in Christ - who God says you are and everything that's yours through a relationship with Jesus - you discover there's nothing that can happen that is too much for you...because there's nothing that's too much for Him! First John 4:4 confirms it: "Little children, you are of God [you belong to Him] and have [already] defeated and overcome them [the agents of the antichrist], because He Who lives in you is greater (mightier) than he who is in the world" (AMPC).

It's so important for us to get this truth down in our hearts and see ourselves as more than conquerors through Jesus, because if we don't, then our enemy, Satan, will be able to confuse us and keep us from victory. And all the enemy wants to do is kill, steal, and destroy what God wants us to have (John 10:10). He wants to diminish you - make you small-minded and small in spirit so you'll live a small, frustrated life.

But we don't have to live that way. Every person who declares that Jesus is Lord, repents of their sin, and gives their heart to God is a child of God and belongs to Him (Romans 10:9-11). In Christ, we are forgiven and made right with God. We have the strength and power to do what His Word says to do and live the full and fulfilling life He has for us.

Do you realize what this means? It means that as we spend time with God in prayer and studying the Bible, we can access the wisdom and strength we need to make right choices and

behave right. It doesn't happen all at once or overnight, but we will make progress every day that we seek God this way. I really want you to understand who you are in Christ as a born-again believer.

When you make a mistake and the enemy comes and tells you, "You're no good," you don't have to take on the guilt and condemnation he wants to put on you. No! You can immediately confess your mistake to God, thank Him for forgiving you and cleansing you with the blood of Jesus, and move forward in the victory of His grace and forgiveness (1 John 1:9).

Here's a scripture that has helped me take hold of who I am in Christ and live with victory over the hardships of this world: "In this [union and communion with Him] love is brought to completion and attains perfection with us...because as He is, so are we in this world" (1 John 4:17 AMPC).

I encourage you to learn who God really is. Get a deeper understanding of His character and His heart for you. Spend time with Him, read His Word, and let Him love you. Know that He loves you unconditionally. God is good, and He wants to bless you and help you. When we know this truth, we don't have to be tormented by doubts about whether God cares or whether He will take care of us.

Whatever your situation is today, God knows about it. He sees you and hears the cry of your heart. And if you will give Him your problems and do what He tells you to do, you will access His overcoming love, grace, and power and be more than a conqueror. Because in Christ, as He is, so are we in this world!

Zach Williams never set out to become one of Christian music's most recognizable voices. In fact, for years he ran in the opposite direction - chasing the Rock-and-Roll dream, numbing the emptiness with addiction, and living on the edge of collapse. But God has a way of turning prodigals into prophets, and Williams' life reads like a modern Damascus Road story.

ZACH WILLIAMS

The Southern Rock Prodigal Who Found His Way Home

There's a grit to Zach Williams' voice that can't be faked. It's the sound of gravel roads and second chances, of a man who has lived hard, run far, and finally surrendered to the grace that chased him down. Long before he became one of Christian music's most recognizable voices, Williams was a wanderer - talented, restless, and dangerously close to losing everything.

Today, he stands as a multi-award-winning artist with more than 1.5 billion streams, multiple RIAA Platinum singles, and a testimony that continues to pull prodigals out of the dark. But the road here was anything but straight.

Williams grew up in Jonesboro, Arkansas, surrounded by faith but not anchored by it. He was athletic, gifted, and driven - qualities that eventually led him into the world of Southern Rock. For years he fronted a touring band, living the lifestyle that came with it: late nights, addiction, and a growing sense of spiritual emptiness.

He has never glamorized that season. In fact, he speaks of it with a kind of holy sobriety. "I was running from God

as hard as I could. I was chasing everything that was destroying me."

The turning point came in a tour van in Europe. A song - Big Daddy Weave's *Redeemed* - played through the speakers. The lyrics hit him like a freight train. In that moment, he knew he couldn't keep living the way he was.

He quit the band. He went home. He began the slow, painful work of rebuilding his marriage, his faith, and his identity. That surrender became the foundation of everything that followed.

Williams' rise in Christian music was swift, but not because he was polished. It was because he was real. His breakout single, *Chain Breaker*, became an anthem for anyone who had ever felt trapped by their past. It shot to No. 1, earned him a Grammy, and introduced the world to a voice that carried both grit and grace.

Songs like *Fear Is a Liar*, *Old Church Choir*, and *Rescue Story* followed - each one a chapter in the same redemption narrative.

"I've always believed in writing songs for real people going through real things," Williams says. "I don't ever want to forget where I came from."

That authenticity is why his music resonates across genres - Christian Country, Southern Rock, Worship, and even Mainstream Country audiences who recognize the truth in his storytelling.

Williams' newest album, "Jesus Loves," released September 19, 2025, marks what he calls his most personal project yet. It leans deeper into his Southern-Rock roots while sharpening the spiritual edge that defines his work.

The title track, *Jesus Loves*, has already become a Top 10 Christian radio hit. But it's the raw honesty of *Killed A Man* that has captured the attention of longtime fans. The song is a confession - an acknowledgment of the old life he buried when he surrendered to Christ.

"This album is an invitation for the misfits, the church kids, and the prodigals," Williams explains. "It's a reminder that no matter your story, you're already loved."

Other standout tracks include:

- *Friend in High Places* - a revival-tent, rootsy celebration
 - *Church Kids* - a joyful collaboration with CAIN
 - *Everything Changed* - a testimony song with the emotional punch of *Rescue Story*
- The album is bold, unvarnished, and deeply human - much like the man who wrote it.

To support the new album, Williams launched the Revival Nights Tour, a cross-country experience featuring We The

Kingdom, Leanna Crawford, and Ben Fuller. But calling it a "tour" feels insufficient. These nights are part concert, part altar call, part spiritual homecoming.

Williams often pauses mid-set to share pieces of his testimony. He talks about addiction, pride, brokenness, and the God who refused to give up on him. "I want people to know that if God can change my life, He can change theirs," he says

Crowds respond - not with polite applause, but with tears, raised hands, and the unmistakable sound of chains hitting the floor.

What makes Zach Williams such a compelling figure in Christian Country is not just his sound - it's his posture. He sings like a man who remembers the pit he was pulled from. He stands shoulder-to-shoulder with the people he ministers to, not above them. His music is for the wanderer, the weary, the ones who feel disqualified by their past.

"This album is for the misfits... the prodigals... the ones who think they've messed up too much," he says. "I want them to know they're already loved."

That message is the heartbeat of his ministry - and the reason his influence continues to grow.





**A SYMPHONY OF FAITH,

There is a certain kind of artist whose story doesn't begin on a stage, in a studio, or under the glow of spotlights. It begins in the quiet places - the fields, the backroads, the pews of a hometown church - where God plants a calling long before the world ever hears the voice. For Christian artist Austin Glover, that calling took root in the soil of Southern Indiana, where small-town life, classical training, and a deep love for the Gospel converged to shape a ministry that is as authentic as it is anointed.

A classically trained vocalist who graduated from Oakland City University in 2020, Austin carries a sound that is both distinctive and versatile. His foundation in classical voice gives him a technical precision and tonal richness that set him apart in Christian and inspirational music. But his artistry is not defined by academia alone. It is shaped by the rhythms of rural life - the early mornings on his grandparents' farm, the long days working in his family's landscaping business, and the wide-open spaces that taught him to breathe deeply and listen closely.

"I've always had a connection with the outdoors," he says. "There's something special about getting behind the wheel, starting the engine, and shifting up through the gears on a back road in the country. It re-centers me and gives me a fresh outlook on many different parts of my life. I do my best thinking with the top down."

That blend of discipline and down-to-earth simplicity is the heartbeat of who Austin is - a young man who thrives in community, learns eagerly from others, and carries a contagious energy that fills any room he enters. But beneath the charisma and the classical training lies something deeper: a calling he first sensed at just fifteen years old. "I was called into Christian music ministry at a young age," he reflects. "My desire has always been to spread the Gospel."

And spread it he has.

ROOTED IN FAMILY, SHAPED BY FAITH

Austin's musical journey is inseparable from the people who poured into him. He speaks with gratitude about the vocal instructors who shaped his technique and the childhood piano teacher who nurtured his early love for music. But the most profound influences weren't found in a studio or classroom - they were found at home.

"I've been blessed to have watched parents as well as grandparents love each other in good times as well as hard times," he says. "That kind of example stays with you."

It was in a small church in Lawrenceville, Illinois, that Austin's ministry first took flight. From those humble beginnings, he continued to grow, refine his craft, and step into opportunities that would eventually place him on some of the most respected stages in Christian music.

Yet even as his platform expanded, Austin remained grounded. When he's not on the road, he serves as worship pastor at Wabash Community Church in Vincennes, Indiana, stepping in as needed to shepherd his home congregation in worship. He also invests deeply in the next generation through his private voice and piano studio, where he teaches students weekly.



“I strive to instill excellence in each student,” he says. “I want to teach them what I’ve learned in my years of experience as an artist.”

A RISING CAREER WITH REMARKABLE MILESTONES

For an artist still early in his career, Austin’s résumé reads like a seasoned performer’s dream list.

He has sung at the Ark Encounter’s 40 Days and 40 Nights, performed at Graceland, and taken the stage at Singing in the Sun. He has opened for award-winning Southern Gospel artist Ivan Parker, a moment he describes as one of the great honors of his ministry.

And in November 2025, Austin was invited to perform for the grand opening celebration of the Lothian and Red Skelton Gallery of Fine Art at the Red Skelton Performing Arts Center in Vincennes, Indiana - a milestone that affirmed both his artistry and his growing influence.

But Austin’s success isn’t measured only in stages and spotlights. It’s also found in the songs that have resonated with listeners across the country.



Austin enjoys spending time in nature with God - along with his favorite sidekick, his dog, Enzo.

His first original Christmas single, *Ring the Bells*, released in November 2022, climbed into the Top 10 on radio charts and reached number 5 in the days leading up to Christmas. He received the Horizon Award from Miller Piano Studio in Nashville in both 2021 and 2022.

More recently, his song *Symphony of Grace* from the album “Then Came Sunday” charted at number 3 on Christian Voice Magazine’s Southern Gospel Top 100 chart, as well as on Faith Country and SOGR Radio. His latest single, *Look Up*, has also made its way onto multiple charts.

“I feel so blessed to have recorded *Symphony of Grace*,” Austin says. “I truly feel that it was the beginning of many

doors God opened for my ministry. It birthed so many ideas for the new project.”

That new project - his second original album - is currently in the works. Austin is collaborating with Dove Award-winning producer John Rowsey and a team of songwriters to craft a collection of songs that are lyrically strong, biblically grounded, and deeply relatable.

“The songs came pouring in,” he says, “but the one that spoke to me the most was a song titled *The Dream Lives On*. The lyric ‘*so keep the faith and faith will keep you strong*’ couldn’t be more true as Christians. We must keep our faith and always seek God’s plan for our life.”

CHALLENGES, GROWTH, AND THE CALL TO STAND FIRM

Every artist faces challenges, and Austin is no exception. But he approaches them with a maturity and perspective that reveal the depth of his faith.

“One of the biggest challenges for myself was making sure all of my songs and lyrics were copyrighted properly and distributed to the correct platforms,” he admits. “Technology and artificial intelligence - even for a young person - can be overwhelming at times to keep up with.”

Yet he sees challenges not as obstacles but as opportunities. “With challenges comes great growth,” he says. “Some of the greatest rewards in ministry are when you know that God is using your ministry for His glory. That is what keeps us striving.”

Austin’s faith has been tested in ways that shaped his resolve. One of the most defining moments came during college, when his ethics professor challenged the Christian worldview expressed in his end-of-semester paper.

“He wasn’t fond of the Christian approach I had taken regarding creation,” Austin recalls. “It was a well-written paper centered around Genesis, and though he respected my view, I know my grade was lower due to our disagreement.”

Years later, Austin ran into that same professor at a coffee shop - and what he saw stunned him.

“He was sitting with some other gentlemen who had Bibles at the table,” Austin says. “I don’t know if he was still trying to reason with them like he did with me, but I pray that just possibly through our interaction a seed was planted.”

That moment reinforced a conviction that guides Austin’s ministry today: stand firm in the faith, even when culture pushes back.

“As Christians we must not conform to what is taking place in society,” he says. “It all begins with time spent with God - through prayer, living our daily life as Christ would, and leaning on God to be the best version of yourself every step of the way.”

He often returns to Philippians 4:6 - 7, a passage that anchors him when anxiety or uncertainty tries to creep in.

“No one is perfect,” he says. “We all have things we struggle with - worrying, anger, pride, or anything that gives us trials. But God’s peace is real.”

A MISSION THAT GOES BEYOND MUSIC

For Austin, music is not the end goal - it is the vessel.

His mission is simple, yet profound: to welcome the Holy Spirit into every venue, every church, every space where he ministers.

“I am a true believer that if we study, prepare, and work hard in our ministry, when the time comes to take that stage, we turn it over to the Holy Spirit,” he says. “He will always deliver in just the perfect way that glorifies Him.”

He knows audiences may come expecting a performance, a show, or a favorite song. But his prayer is always the same: “That everyone will leave one of my shows feeling full - and will step out and share the good news of Jesus with the world.”

THE ROAD AHEAD

Austin Glover is still early in his journey, but his ministry already carries the marks of someone God is shaping for long-term impact. His classical training, his rural roots, his unwavering faith, and his commitment to excellence have created a foundation that is both sturdy and Spirit-led.

He is an artist who knows where he came from, who he belongs to, and where he is going.

And as he continues writing, recording, teaching, and traveling, one thing is certain: Austin Glover is a voice for this generation - not because he seeks the spotlight, but because he seeks the Savior.



His story is still being written, but the melody is unmistakable.

A symphony of grace.

A testimony of faith.

A life poured out for the glory of God.





New Poll Shows Leading 2028 Democrat and Republican Candidates

A California based conservative activist says a new poll shows that two Californians are the early Democrat front-runners for 2028. Meanwhile, Republicans have a very deep pool to choose from.

A new Harvard-Harris poll of potential 2028 Democrat presidential candidates found Kamala Harris, the 2024 failed nominee, leading with 39%. Fellow Californian Gov. Gavin Newsom was second with 30%, followed by Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez with 12%. Pennsylvania Gov. Josh Shapiro garnered only 9% in fourth place, with Illinois Gov. J.B. Pritzker at 7%. Only 4% indicated that they wanted someone else.

Craig DeLuz, spokesman for the California Republican Assembly, says that Harris has actively and aggressively come out on the wrong side of every 80-20 issue.

"It doesn't matter what it is, whether it's immigration, whether it's the economy, whether it's transgenderism in our schools. Whatever it is, she's come out on the wrong side of all of those issues," states DeLuz. "And that's why she will be a failed candidate once again on top of the fact that she can barely put together a coherent thought when challenged by anyone that is not doing propaganda as opposed to press."

On the other hand, DeLuz says that Newsom is much more adept at communicating. "When I say that, I mean he lies, and he's a very good liar. Now, I don't know if he's a very believable liar, but he makes you believe that he believes it. He is someone who will lie and adopt whatever position will make him popular enough for him to win the next election," says DeLuz. "So, Gavin Newsom is a much more dangerous than Kamala Harris."

However, DeLuz says that both Harris and Newsom will have it tough beating whoever the Republicans put up. The Harvard-Harris poll showed that, on the Republican side, Vice President J.D. Vance has a commanding 53% lead over

Donald Trump Jr. with 21% and Secretary of State Marco Rubio with 17%.

DeLuz is impressed with the Republican field. "I think, on the Republican side, we've got a very deep pool. I think we've got a lot of potential candidates, and I think a lot of very potential good candidates. I think in the end it comes down to Marco Rubio or J.D. Vance," states DeLuz.

He believes that Rubio has already said that he would not run against Vance. "I would love to see the two of them debate one another because I think both of them are of high intellect. I think that both of them are of high moral character," says DeLuz.

He is confident about a general election matchup with the Democrat frontrunners. "Right now, those who are leading, in my opinion, will have a very, very tough time beating whoever the Republicans put up," concludes DeLuz.

New Sharia-Free America Caucus Boldly Promotes Effort to Ban Islamic Law in U.S.

Shrugging off criticism and claims of discrimination, a Republican congressman is neither apologizing nor backing down from a vow to beat back and defeat Sharia-compliant Islam in the United States.

Describing the newly-formed Sharia-Free America Caucus, Rep. Brandon Gill (R-Texas) told American Family Radio the main goal of himself and other GOP lawmakers is to ban Sharia law in the U.S. "I think that's about as basic, and commonsense, as it gets," Gill told show host Jenna Ellis.

The controversial congressional caucus, which launched in December, was started by two Republican congressmen from Texas, Keith Self and Chip Roy. It now includes 30-plus members, representing 18 U.S. states, who support passage of the Preserving a Sharia-Free America Act authored by Rep. Roy.

In Gill's own state, a Muslim imam likely helped Gill and other GOP lawmakers court new caucus members. That's

because the imam, Qasim ibn Ali Khan, harassed Muslim store owners in Houston over the products they sell. The products, such as alcohol and pork, are considered "haram" in Islam.

In a related move, Gov. Greg Abbott signed House Bill 4211 into law last fall that bans residential developments from implementing Sharia-compliant communities. He took action after the planned East Plano Islamic Center - EPIC City - development northeast of Dallas.

Supporters of the caucus say Sharia represents a threat to national identity, citing concerns over immigration, cultural assimilation and national security.

They reference developments like EPIC City - a project they describe as a Sharia-only compound - as evidence of growing ideological infiltration.

Critics, including civil rights groups like the ACLU, argue that such measures are unnecessary and discriminatory. They war that banning religious legal principles could infringe on First Amendment rights, as religious individuals of all faiths may reference religious law in personal matters like wills or arbitration.

Gill told Ellis the caucus recognizes that Islam is not just a religious faith but a political ideology, too. That means that form of Islam is not compatible with core constitutional issues, such as freedom of speech and freedom of religion.

"I mean, these are core constitutional principles that undergird our entire Western civilization," Gill stressed. "We just don't align with political Islam in these matters and many others. That's what people are concerned with."

The controversy over Sharia law is a campaign issue for a Texas congressional candidate, Abteen Vaziri. An Iranian-born Christian, he is currently in a Republican primary for the 32nd District and has made an anti-Sharia stance part of his campaign.

"As someone whose entire family is Muslim, I'm not down with Sharia law," Vaziri, speaking at a candidate forum, recently told a room of Muslims.

Gill, who was elected to Congress last year, represents the 26th District that includes Denton, Wise, Tarrant, and Cooke counties in North Texas. He told the AFR program his constituents vocally oppose the explosion of Islam in and around his congressional district, which is located north of

what is called the Dallas-Ft. Worth Metroplex. "They love this country the way it is," he said. "One of the biggest concerns that I hear from constituents is Islam. It is the Islamization of North Texas."

The growth of Islam in Texas, and the mosques being built all over the state, Gill said, are why the caucus is also not running from the issue of immigration. "We've got to recognize the basic truth that not all cultures are equal," Gill argued. "They're not all equally good. Not all belief systems are equally good."

Aware of Somali-linked fraud uncovered in Minnesota, Gill himself has introduced legislation to ban future immigration from Somalia after it was learned Somalis have stolen billions from American taxpayers.

Treatment of Christians in Iran Grows Worse After Conflict with Israel, U.S.

Iran remains a dangerous place for Christians.

Iran is the site of the fastest growing church in the world, but Todd Nettleton of Voice of the Martyrs said that our brothers and sisters there are paying a heavy price. "As Christians, they are seen as allies of the U.S., allies of Israel, and in fact, one of the things that has happened even since the war this past summer is we're seeing more serious charges against Christians when they're arrested," said Nettleton.

Since the U.S. bombing of Iran's nuclear facilities, charges against Christians are now much more political in nature. "A year ago, they might have been charged with having illegal printed materials like the Bible, they might have been charged with being some type of a security threat or undermining the government, and now, they're being charged with espionage, they are being charged as spies, sometimes as Zionist spies."

That charge carries a potential death penalty. "It seems to have grown out of the war with Israel, and out of that idea that Christians are sympathetic to Israel, they're sympathetic to America," said Nettleton. "The idea that is common in the Middle East is that Christianity is a western religion, America is a Christian country, so therefore if you're a Christian you're sympathetic to America."

A PREACHER'S PERSPECTIVE

Can We Know God?

Jerry Roach

I read these words in the NEW CENTURY VERSION of the Bible... "To a god who is not known." This is an inscription on an altar in Athens where St. Paul was preaching. How sad it is that so many people, including very religious folks, do not know Him. I knew that there was a God. I think there's something inside every person that that says, "There is a God." But I didn't know Him personally and intimately.

In his sermon to the Athenians (Acts 17:22-31), Paul acknowledges that they are a very religious people and makes mention of all their gods as evidenced by many idols and altars, including the altar of "the unknown god." Paul then proceeds to tell them about this God that they worship but don't know.

Paul declares to them that He is:

*THE CREATOR GOD - He made the earth and everything in it. (vs 24)

*TRANSCENDENT - "Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples." He is high above all His creation. (vs 24)

*OMNIPOTENT - All-powerful, lacking nothing. (vs 25)

*LIFE GIVER - Gives and sustains all life. (Vs25)

*IMMANENT - God is present in the lives of His people and He is KNOWABLE. "Seek the Lord...find Him...He is not far from every one of us." (Vs27)

*LIFE - "...In Him we live, and move, and have our being..." (vs 28)

Paul is saying THE GOD Who created heaven and earth, who gives life and everything necessary to sustain life, Who needs nothing, Who is Omnipotent, Who is High and Holy above all, is also very near to every one of us and WANTS us to KNOW Him. Awesome!!!

The Bible says that He gave His only Son Jesus, Who became one of us and gave His life for us. I don't think we can fully comprehend all that took place on that day in the heart of God. I think about how Jesus was deserted by his friends, stretched out on a cross, suspended between Heaven and earth and it seemed as though even His Father couldn't bear to watch what was happening and had to turn away when Jesus cried out from the tree in anguish, "My God, My God, why...?"

Have you ever thought about why? Do you realize the great depths to which God has gone because He wants to enter into a relationship with you? Have you opened your heart to Him? Do you KNOW GOD? The Bible says that God wants you to seek after Him and you will find Him. He's not very far from every one of us. Call out to Him, THE TRUE GOD WHO IS KNOWABLE.

When the Church Types Before It Thinks

Why We Must Talk About Cyber Bullying

There's something about a keyboard that gives people courage they would never have face-to-face. Words come easier. Judgment feels justified. And empathy often gets left out entirely.

Recently, a painful incident involving Karlye Hopper, daughter of Kim Hopper and part of the beloved Gospel group The Hoppers, brought this issue into sharp focus.

What should have been a moment handled with grace instead became a reminder of how quickly criticism - especially from those who identify as "church people" - can cross the line into cruelty.

When Opinion Turns Into Harm

Let's be clear: everyone has a right to an opinion. But having a right to speak does not mean we are free from responsibility for the impact of our words.

Behind a screen, it's easy to forget there's a real person on the other side - someone with a family, a calling, a heart, and feelings. What may feel like "just a comment" to one person can become a deep wound to another.

In this situation, words were spoken that didn't bring correction or clarity - they brought pain. And that pain didn't stop at the individual being targeted. It affected family members, relationships, and an entire community watching it unfold.

A Needed Conversation

That's why I recently sat down with Kim Hopper for an honest conversation about what happened, how it affected her daughter Karlye, and the emotional toll online attacks can take - especially when they come from people who claim faith as their foundation.

This wasn't about stirring drama. It was about telling the truth.

Cyber bullying doesn't always look like name-calling or threats. Sometimes it shows up wrapped in religious language, disguised as "concern," "discernment," or "just being honest." But intent doesn't erase impact.

The Church Has to Do Better

If the church is going to speak into culture, it must also be willing to look inward.

Scripture calls us to speak the truth - but it also calls us to do so in love. Before posting, commenting, or sharing, we need to ask ourselves:

- Would I say this to their face?
- Would I want this said about my child?
- Does this bring healing - or harm?

Social media has given everyone a platform, but it has also removed the pause that used to exist when words were spoken in person.

That pause matters.

Southern Gospel Bullying

Bullying within the Gospel music industry is a conversation we can no longer avoid.

This is a genre built on faith, hope, and the message of Christ - yet too often, artists and families find themselves wounded by comments and criticism coming from inside their own community.

Instead of standing together on the same team, words are sometimes used to divide, belittle, and tear one another down, often under the guise of “discernment” or “having an opinion.”

As a genre that carries the name Christian, we should be setting the standard for love, grace, and accountability - not modeling the same bullying behavior we condemn in the world.

If our music proclaims redemption and compassion, then our words - on stage and online - should reflect that same spirit.

Why This Matters

We talk about cyber bullying because silence allows it to continue. We talk about it because words have consequences. And we talk about it because faith should never be used as a weapon.

This recent incident is not just about one family - it’s about a pattern we’ve allowed to grow unchecked. If we don’t address it, it will keep hurting people who never deserved it.

It’s time to slow down, show restraint, and remember that kindness is not weakness - it’s a choice.

And sometimes, the most Christ-like thing we can do...is simply not hit “post.”

If You Have Been Bullied

If you’ve been bullied - online or in person - please know that you don’t have to face it alone, and you don’t have to minimize the hurt it causes.

The first step is to tell someone you trust - a friend, family member, pastor, counselor, or mentor - because silence often gives

bullying more power than it deserves.


Save messages or screenshots if the behavior is ongoing, and don’t hesitate to set boundaries, including blocking or reporting abusive accounts when necessary.

Most importantly, seek professional support if the weight of the words is affecting your mental health. Talking with a counselor or therapist is a sign of strength, not weakness.

Your worth is not defined by what someone says about you online. Getting help is how you begin to reclaim your voice, your peace, and your sense of safety.

Where Food Meets Faith and Every Dish Tells a Story

When the Soil Starts Talking

March always sneaks up on me. One day I'm stirring a pot of winter stew, and the next I'm standing on my porch with my apron still on, listening to the ground thaw. My grandmama used to say, "Baby, when the soil starts talking, you best be ready to answer."

I didn't understand her then, but I do now. March is a month of holy in-betweens - not quite winter, not quite spring. It's the season when God whispers, "Prepare." Not rush. Not bloom. Prepare.

When I was a girl, this was the time Mama would pull out her seed packets - tomatoes, okra, pole beans, squash - and spread them across the kitchen table like a deck of promises. She'd run her fingers over each one and pray under her breath. She didn't call it prayer, but that's what it was. A woman talking to God about the things she hoped would grow.

I find myself doing the same thing now. Not always with seeds, but with life. With the things I've buried deep in the soil of my heart - dreams, hurts, hopes, and the quiet places where I still need the Lord to breathe.

March reminds me that God works in the unseen long before anything breaks the surface. The roots come first. The strengthening comes first. The hidden work comes first. And that's good news for anybody who feels like they're waiting on something to change.

So today, I'm inviting you into my kitchen for something simple, comforting, and perfect for this in-between season - a dish that carries you from the last chill of winter into the first breath of spring. It's the kind of food that tastes like hope rising.

Early-Spring Chicken & Herb Dumplings

A lighter, brighter take on a classic - perfect for those first warm days when you're still craving comfort but ready for something new.

Ingredients

For the stew:

- 2 tbsp butter
- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 medium onion, diced
- 2 carrots, sliced
- 2 celery stalks, sliced
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 3 cups cooked shredded chicken
- 6 cups chicken broth
- 1 cup peas (fresh or frozen)
- 1 tsp dried thyme
- 1 tsp dried parsley
- Salt and pepper to taste

For the herb dumplings:

- 1 ½ cups all-purpose flour
- 2 tsp baking powder
- ½ tsp salt
- 2 tbsp cold butter, grated
- ¾ cup buttermilk
- 2 tbsp fresh chopped herbs (parsley, chives, or dill)

Instructions

1. Melt butter and olive oil in a large pot. Add onion, carrots, and celery. Cook until softened.
2. Stir in garlic and cook one minute more.
3. Add chicken, broth, thyme, parsley, salt, and pepper. Bring to a gentle simmer.
4. In a bowl, whisk flour, baking powder, and salt. Cut in grated butter. Stir in buttermilk and herbs until just combined.
5. Drop spoonfuls of dough into the simmering stew. Cover and cook 12–15 minutes without lifting the lid.
6. Add peas during the last 5 minutes. Taste and adjust seasoning.

Serve warm, with gratitude for the God who works in quiet places.



If February taught us to honor where we've come from, March teaches us to prepare for where we're going. Don't despise the slow days. Don't rush the roots. God is doing more beneath the surface than you can see.

And when the soil starts talking - in your garden or in your spirit - answer with faith.


