


















## **Cross**Fire

#### What the Bible Says About Divorce (Part 2)

s we stated last month, God established marriage for humanity's good in Genesis 2:18, 21-24 as part of His plan. We see Him declare that it isn't good for man to be alone, and then He creates someone special to fill that yoid.

The idea of "one flesh" is an eternal bond designed by Him that endures until one partner passes away. This only adds more significance to this sacred union and underscores God's faithfulness and commitment to His people.

Yet human imperfection often results in brokenness, even within God-ordained relationships. Malachi 2:14-16 offers a stark reminder of God's position on divorce. In verses 15-16, we learn that "God hates divorce." These words encapsulate the grief and heartbreak associated with divorce. Still, we must acknowledge the reality of divorce, leaving individuals and families grappling with its repercussions.

As we explore this challenging topic, we must ask what the Bible says about divorce and reconciling God's design for marriage with human failure. By reading Scripture, we can try to understand God's heart regarding this topic and find His guidance for navigating situations with grace, truthfulness, and redemption.

#### DIVOREC IS NOT THE UNPARDONABLE SIN

While painful and not in accordance with God's ideal for marriage, divorce is not the unpardonable sin. Scripture makes this clear in Matthew 12:31-32 by outlining that only willful rejection of His saving grace (blasphemy of the Holy Spirit) falls beyond forgiveness. Divorce, like all sins or failures, may be redeemed through repentance and restoration by His grace. To judge someone for experiencing divorce is to misunderstand God's mercy and love for everyone. He excels at creating beauty out of broken relationships, even as opposed to condemnation. To condemn someone for going through a divorce is to misunderstand His mercy and the depth of His love - no one stands above His grace! No one stands above His grace when it comes to healing broken relationships.

As believers, we must resist the tendency to judge those who have experienced divorce and recognize that we all benefit from God's grace when dealing with our brokenness. Divorce should not define someone's worth or ability to serve God. Church leaders should use compassion, understanding, and support as a means of helping divorced individuals rebuild their lives with the aid of God's love.

Labeling divorce as an unforgivable sin misrepresents God and risks alienating those in desperate need of His healing touch. Remember that the Gospel offers redemption for everyone, including those whose marriages ended in

divorce. Our responsibility should be to extend the grace and hope that we have received, thus reflecting Christ's unconditional love.

#### A BILL OF DIVORCEMENT

In Deuteronomy 24, Moses introduces the concept of a bill of divorce as an attempt to control and regulate divorce rather than promote or encourage it.

Marriage had become chaotic at this point in history with divorce becoming a convenient practice. Two schools of thought dominated this discussion. The school of Shammai took an ultra-strict approach, teaching that divorce should only be permissible under extreme circumstances, such as severe matrimonial offenses involving indecency or something inappropriate in marriage.

The school of Hillel took an opposing view, accepting divorce for practically any reason, including burned dinners or a wife losing her physical attractiveness. This view became widely popular, particularly among Pharisees, who often saw women as disposable and treated marriage as subject to their desires and will.

Moses' intention in discussing divorce was to mitigate its harmful impact on women and children, who, unfortunately bore the brunt of such recklessness. Mosaic law sought to bring order and fairness into an otherwise chaotic practice by setting conditions for divorce. Still, Pharisees side-stepped its true intent with clever interpretations that undermined its purpose while disregarding marriage as a sacred institution.

When the Pharisees posed their question to Jesus in Matthew 19, inquiring whether it was legal for men to divorce their wives for any reason, they intended to trap Him. Instead, Jesus changed the subject by emphasizing how marriage was created as God intended it from its very inception. Jesus reminded them that marriage was more than a civil contract; it was a divine covenant wherein two became one flesh - an unbreakable bond ordained by God Himself. Moses permitted divorce due to the human hardness of the heart. At the same time, Jesus pointed out that this concession should not be seen as an endorsement but should emphasize instead the sanctity and permanency of marriage.

#### THE DEVASTATION OF DIVORCE

Divorce can upend the lives of both individuals involved and their families and communities as a whole, leaving an everlasting ripple effect that touches every corner of life. Divorce ranks among life's most traumatic events, second only to death itself, since it signals the death of a relationship built on trust, love, and commitment. Divorce often has cascading effects that reshape the lives of everyone involved - emotionally draining experiences. Feelings of betrayal, failure, guilt, and grief can remain long after the legal processes conclude, while mental health challenges like anxiety, depression, and difficulty in trusting others are common results of divorce proceedings.

Divorce can have devastating and far-reaching repercussions for children who are involved, altering both their emotional and psychological development in profound ways. Children may feel abandoned, confused, and uncertain as their family structure shifts dramatically. Loss of stability can result in anxiety, depression, or behavioral issues for children of divorced or separated parents. Younger children often struggle to understand why their parents no longer cohabitate, while older ones may express anger or resentment toward one or both sides. Academic performance may suffer as children become distracted or overwhelmed by changes at home, impacting both their schoolwork and social relationships. Withdrawal from friends or exhibiting difficulty in trusting others, for instance, can potentially last into adulthood and sometimes perpetuate a cycle of brokenness in future relationships or commitments.

Divorce can create immense strain and disruption within families. Extended family relationships involving grandparents, aunts, and uncles can also become estranged as new dynamics shift within the family unit. Friendships or professional connections may deteriorate as those going

through divorce struggle to maintain social connections while dealing with the stigma attached to their situation. All of these effects can leave lasting emotional scars throughout the lives of all those involved.

Spiritually, divorce can test a person's sense of identity and faith. For believers, divorce may seem like an act against God that violates His expectations, leading to feelings of guilt and spiritual turmoil. That's why Jesus addressed divorce with such clarity and kindness. His teachings remind us of the consequences surrounding divorce while leading us back toward His ideal of marriage - one characterized by love, faithfulness, and lasting commitment.

By emphasizing the sacredness of marriage, Jesus sought to restore God's high regard for this institution and protect families from the potentially devastating effect of divorce. God intends for marriage to be a haven, providing emotional, physical, and spiritual support for spouses and their children alike. Marriage provides stability while supporting growth, its purpose exemplifying His will for His people. Upholding Christ's vision requires courage and dedication in a society that often treats marriage as disposable. Christ calls us back to divine standards of an unbreakable covenant reflecting His steadfast love for His people.

## Harmonizing Faith and Country Music

n the rolling hills of Rainsville, Alabama, a family band is making waves in Christian country music. The Fortner Brothers - Layne (22), Kyle (19), Kennon (19), and Konner (19) - have transformed their childhood passion for music into a ministry that reaches audiences across the nation. With a rich blend of Country instrumentation and faith-filled lyrics, their music not only entertains but also spreads the message of Christ.

With their father, Phillip, on keyboards, and their mother, Kayla, as their first harmony teacher, the brothers have created a dynamic sound that honors both their musical heritage and their Christian faith. From humble beginnings in their children's church choir to performances at major venues, their journey is a testament to passion, perseverance, and purpose.

Music has always been a part of the Fortner household. Their mother, Kayla, introduced them to harmony at a young age, leading them to church performances. But it was their growing love for playing instruments that led them to form a band.

"At ages eight and ten, we started guitar lessons. We really enjoyed learning and asked our parents if we could become a band. Mom and dad surprised us that Christmas with a bass guitar and a drum set, so we could start the band. I decided to play the bass, and Kennon decided to play the drums," Konner recalls.

A Christmas gift sparked a lifelong passion, leading them to hone their skills at Chris Robert's School of Music. Kennon learned drums from Mark Herndon, Alabama's former drummer. Starting with church and school events, their 2015 performance at a family friend's church opened doors to invitations across multiple states and prestigious venues.

The Fortner Brothers' ability to blend classic Country sounds with faith-based messages quickly caught the attention of music industry professionals. In 2022, Nashville producer Rick Schweinsberg approached them about singing Christian Country music. It was an opportunity they didn't take lightly.

"We praved about it and decided to take him up on his offer." the brothers shared. "We've always loved Country music, and this was a way to stay true to our sound while keeping our focus on Christ."

That decision led to a surge in popularity. In 2024, they were nominated for both 'New Artist of the Year' and 'Group of the Year' by the Inspirational Country Music Awards. Their album "No Future in the Past" was even considered in the first round of votes for a Grammy.

Their music isn't just about catchy tunes; it's deeply personal. Each song carries a message, often inspired by real-life experiences. One such song, Numbered, holds special meaning for Layne.

"One of my friends lost his life in a car accident. I didn't think about someone my age's life getting cut short until it happened. I learned that we are never promised another minute on this earth! We need to be right with Him and live every moment for Him! When we were pitched the song Numbered, it put into words everything I felt. I knew that we had to record it!" Layne recalls.

Their third album, "Things That Never Rust" debuted on February 22, 2025, and has already been receiving great feedback. The album maintains their signature classic Country sound, with a mix of Western swing and '90s Country influences.

"Mine might be On Our Knees," Konner shares when asked about his favorite track. "It has a powerful message with a very compelling story. I really like how it shows the power of prayer."

"I like them all in different ways," Kyle adds. They all vary enough in a Country flair that there should be something for everyone, but they are all about Christ and stay rooted in that classic Country sound.













Beyond the stage, the Fortner Brothers see themselves as concerts are high-energy, but the focus remains on spreading the Gospel.

"We have played at the Ark Encounter three times. It has always been a wonderful experience! Everyone there is wonderful to work with, and it is great to be able to share the Gospel with so many people who are visiting the Ark. We have found that many who visit do not know the Lord," Kennon shares.

For Kyle, the greatest challenge has been stepping out of his comfort zone. "My greatest challenge has been coming out of my shell and feeling comfortable singing solos, as well as pushing myself to become a better musician," he admits. "The greatest reward is reaching people for the Kingdom."

Their music is making an impact, with songs like *Jesus*, Cause I Want To, Numbered, Keep Keepin' On, and Honky Tonk Missionary charting on Christian Country radio. Their latest album includes a tribute to their late grandfathers and a cover of Alan Jackson's Small Town Southern Man.

When asked if they consider themselves role models, more than just musicians; they are messengers of faith. Their Kyle responds with humility: "I don't want to be a role model as when someone sees me, they say, 'Oh look, there's Kyle!' But I do want to be the role model that the Lord calls us to be, and that is to live like Christ. And when people see me, whether they remember my name or not, I want them to see Christ in me," Kyle states.

> The goal of the Fortner Brothers group is and has always been to take Christ to the world, and if you attend a concert, you should expect a fun, high-energy, spirit-led concert in a Christian Country style.

> The Fortner Brothers' journey continues with a growing fan base, award nominations, and a mission to glorify God through Country music, whether on local or national stages.



















A Songwriter's Spiritual Journey in Bluegrass Gospel





Even though I loved God and went to church every week, I had no idea that there was power available to me to overcome the hurts from the past and the struggles of daily life. And everything that came along that was hard to handle, defeated me.

But I was so grateful when I found out in God's Word that not only is He powerful, but He wants to fill us with His power. He promises in His Word that we can have abundant life in Christ because He has overcome the world (John 10:10; 16:33)!

The truth is, as believers in Christ, we don't have to live weak, wimpy, pitiful, pathetic, barely-getting-by lives. We can have God's power working in us to enable us to do whatever we need to do!

Some people have the misconception that when they give their lives to Jesus, they will no longer have any problems. It would be nice if this were true, but in this world, we WILL have trials and tribulations. The good news is we can cheer up anyway because Jesus has overcome the world.

In John 16:33 (ESV), Jesus says, "...In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."

No one can promise you a problem-free life, but God promises that if you will put your trust in Him, He will give you a faith that enables you to rise above the problems you face. And when you get through them, you'll be stronger on the other side than you were before you had them.

Knowing you can have power from God to live in this world is one thing, but learning to believe this truth and walk in it is the key to having victory over the trials and suffering you face. I love Philippians 3:10 because it says we can actually experience the same power that raised Christ from the dead.

In this verse, the apostle Paul says his determined purpose was to "know Him [experientially, becoming more thoroughly acquainted with Him, understanding the remarkable wonders of His Person more completely] and [in that same way experience] the power of His resurrection [which overflows and is active in believers], and [that I may share] the fellowship of His sufferings, by being continually conformed [inwardly into His likeness even] to His death [dying as He did]" (AMP).

This is an amazing and encouraging promise from God, because we all face problems and have weaknesses we can't overcome in our own strength or effort. But if we are determined to trust God in every situation, all the time, we can fight the good fight of faith by HIS grace.

Romans 8:37 (AMP) says: "Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors and gain an overwhelming victory through Him who loved us [so much that He died for us]." I love this phrase "more than conquerors." But what does it really mean?

Being more than a conqueror means that before you ever have a problem, you are confident that you have whatever it takes to overcome it through your relationship with Christ. In other words, you know you have the victory before you ever get the problem.

Now, in order to "qualify" for the power of God, we must first come to the place where we recognize that in and of ourselves, we are weak and we have limitations without God. If we didn't have any weakness, we wouldn't realize we need Him. And one of the best prayers we can ever pray is "God, I need You, and I'm nothing without You!" (John 15:5.)

It's so important for us to understand this because if we wait until we have a problem that's too big for us to handle before we rely on God's strength, then we're setting ourselves up to fail.

The best thing we can do to live this life in victory is to continually seek God with our whole heart, realizing we're desperate for Him all the time. Spend time with Him in prayer and studying His Word every day. Then, when the storms of life happen, you will be confident that in Christ, you already have everything you need to overcome them...and you'll experience the power of His resurrection as you rise above them!



im was born on a naval base in Illinois, raised in New Orleans, and lives in Scottsville, Kentucky. He was saved by the amazing grace of Christ on May 7, 1972, at the age of eighteen. He graduated New Orleans Baptist Seminary with an associate's degree in youth ministry in several states.

To understand the man Jim is today, one would need a glimpse into where he came from. A failed marriage would cause him to feel worthless, deepened by those affirming that a divorced person was no longer useful in ministry. The fear of losing it all, simply trying to survive, and subconsciously trying to find his way back to God, Jim found Country music.

Feeling as if he were living the life of a sad Country song, Jim travelled and sang Country music for the next several years. It seemed things were looking up for Jim when he married Jeanette in 1992. It was during this time God's hand in his life became evident to him. He says, "After I repented and got my life straight with Jesus, I immediately started praying, seeking what God wanted me to do."

Although Jim enjoyed singing bass with a quartet for a while, he was still a little hesitant about his path choices. "I felt right at home and thoroughly enjoyed my time there, but I wanted to be certain of God's path for me, never wanting to go down the wrong path(s) like I had done before in my life."

It was in that moment God firmly planted Proverbs 3:6 in Jim's heart: "In everything you do, put God first; He will direct and crown your efforts with success." From that point on, Jim totally surrendered all his future plans and ideas over to God and has never looked back. Jim went on to sing lead. baritone, and bass for numerous other quartets.

While working jobs that didn't conflict with a singing schedule, Jim honed his craft, spending six incredible summers studying at the Charles Novell School of Music. Forever learning, Jim now has eight summers of study under his belt and has been part of the teaching staff for eight years.

Through the Charles Novell school, Jim would amass a wealth of influences in Charles Novell, Rob Novell, Danny Funderburk, Bill Baise, Ann Downing, Jeff Stice, Donnie Sumner, Billy Blackwood, Dan Keeton, Nick Bruno, Bev McCann, Jimmy Jones, Mary Fay Jackson, and Mark Fain. Pastor Bob Melvin gave endless encouragement, as well as Glen Payne of The Cathedrals, telling Jim to remember that God gave the talent and the desire, "Now go, sing and serve with a servant's heart."

All the while, staying positive has not always been easy for Jim. He admits, "There were many times when disappointment and frustration drove me to quit, but God would always open a new door for me."

One such new door was the opportunity to sing with The Church Music Ministry and went on to serve in music and Keetons. Jim recalls, "Dan Keeton, tenor singer for Gold City, took a chance on me! He hired me to sing baritone for his group, The Keetons. Under Dan's wings, God brought fine-tuning to the training, hard work and experiences that would be required of me in the coming solo ministry. God knew what was coming!"

When The Keeton's disbanded for Dan to move on with Gold City, Jim decided not to sit at home and wait for another singing group to call. He would take that giant leap of faith, establishing a full-time, solo Country/Gospel ministry. 'Putting God first' was born, Sheldon gave total release for God to take charge.



God certainly did take charge with Jim's first project, "His Grace," with Donnie Sumner. Jim signed with Homeland Inspiration Group's Mont Eagle Records, releasing his first-ever charting single, God Is Looking At My Heart. He recorded two more albums with Scott Godsey, Bev McCann and Nick Bruno. His first music video, I Belong to Jesus, went viral. Jim has gone on to record several other videos that can be found on YouTube or TV shows ie: Family Friendly Entertainment on Roku and other streaming services.

Jim has continued to record and release several projects over the years with none other than Mark Fain, a multi-Grammy award winning producer and musician and awardwinning Steve Chandler as his engineer.

Traveling and singing from coast to coast for more than twenty years, Jim's motto remains, 'Putting od First.' Along the way, Sheldon has held onto a very successful charting ladder with songs like, I Would Crawl All The Way, I Saw A Man, I'm Going Home, Church Like We Knew, Old School, He's There, He's A Mighty Good Friend, and God Is Looking At My Heart. Jim's latest project "Gloves" has resulted in more great radio hits, Sin is Color Blind along with his latest single and video, Father of the Fatherless.

In 2012, Jim became co-producer of The Music City Show along with Scott Godsey and Bev McCann. He was also a co-host and featured performer on the show. Here, viewers witnessed 'The Positive Cowboy' singing what was alive in his heart. Seven seasons of The Music City Show are still airing today on FFE and a few other outlets. Whether on TV or on stage, Jim sings of God's love and mercy - all with such a positive faith and a smiling face.





## Hegseth's Fitness Memo Could be Flank Attack on Women in Combat

A military watchdog that has pleaded for years for a more lethal armed forces, and warned about a weakened one, is praising new combat fitness standards announced by Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth that address a lingering issue: women in combat.

Elaine Donnelly, president of the Center for Military Readiness, has waited a long time for the announcement Secretary Hegseth made when he signed a memorandum directing the military branches to implement tough genderneutral standards for men and women.

"What he wants," she says, "is high, uncompromised standards in the combat arms units. We're talking about infantry, armor, artillery, special operations forces, Navy SEALS, Delta Force, and the like."

Donnelly and CMR witnessed President Obama hollow out the U.S. armed forces in 2012, now 13 years ago, when the radically liberal president opened up front-line combat units to women.

To follow through on Obama's order, the U.S. Army dropped its Army Physical Fitness Test and replaced it with the misnamed Army Combat Fitness Test. What was supposed to a gender-neutral standard for men and women crumbled under the weight of real life, however, when women suffered predictably high failure rates.

At the elite, body-breaking Ranger School, for example, 100 women participated in a pre-training phase in January 2015 to get them ready for the school. By April of that year, however, only 19 had qualified for its first phase, a 15-day test known as the Darby Phase. By the end of Darby, in June of 2025, the remaining eight female Ranger School candidates had failed it on the first attempt.

In August of that year, the national media was celebrating the two female Army officers who passed Ranger School and got their Ranger tab. A story by People, however, cited multiple sources who said a Pentagon general had ordered the Ranger School to make sure a female candidate passed the course by giving them multiple chances not offered to men.

"Well, it turns out that that was a promise that could not be kept," Donnolly points out. "It didn't work. It has shattered the theories and promises about gender equality in the combat arms."

After stating as recently as last November he "straight up" opposes women in combat units, Hegseth has said more recently women can serve in those roles if they meet the same physical standards.

At his heated confirmation hearings, Hegseth was accused by livid Democrats of tip-toeing around the issue and having an "11th hour conversion" over women in combat.

In a post on X, filmed during a military flight from Japan, Hegseth showed the memo he was about to sign and said his goal is a more lethal armed forces.

"For far too long," Hegseth said, "we have allowed standards to slip. We've had different standards for men/women serving in combat arms, MOS, and jobs. That's not acceptable, and it changes right now."

#### State's Majority Party is Punishing Parents

Little stands in the way of a trans rights bill the Colorado House has moved on to the Senate.

GOP Representative Jarvis Caldwell says Colorado HB25-1312, Legal Protections for Transgender Individuals, demonizes parents who want to protect their children from harmful drugs or surgeries. He calls it "Orwellian."

"If your child is confused about their gender identity, and you don't affirm that confusion, that delusion, then you are guilty of child abuse, and you can lose custody of your children," he summarizes.

Over the weekend in mid April, Democrats used a couple of House rules to immediately cut off debate and call for a vote on the bill, depriving Caldwell and others the opportunity to make their cases against it. They pushed through a slate of controversial gender and abortion bills on Sunday.

"It should alarm every American that Colorado's majority used a Sunday – a day typically reserved for family and prayer – to force through four of the most extreme bills of the session," Republican House Minority Leader Rose Pugliese told Fox News Digital.

While "weekend work" is a "tactic the majority uses to punish the minority," Pugliese said it was especially "unprecedented" this time because of the highly controversial nature of the bills.

"There was no filibuster, no delay – just a determined effort to shut down discussion on legislation that directly affects parental rights, public safety, and the use of taxpayer dollars," she said. "They know how much negative attention this has been getting nationwide, and so what they did was they silenced us," Caldwell laments. "They did not let us represent our constituents."

Curious about how much stakeholdering went on, he did ask the Democrats if they talked with any parents who opposed the bill when crafting it.

Rep. Yara Zokaie showed the disdain her party has for parents or other advocates for children, comparing them to

the Ku Klux Klan. "A well stakeholded bill does not need to be discussed with hate groups, and we don't ask someone passing civil rights legislation to go ask the KKK their opinion," she told Republicans during a committee hearing last week.

Monica Duran (D), the state House majority leader, says the four bills – SB25-183, which requires taxpayers to fund abortion services; HB25-1309, mandating insurers cover transgender procedures regardless of age; HB25-1312, which imposes state-mandated gender policies on schools and considers it "coercive control" in child custody cases when a parent does not affirm a child's gender identity; and SB25-129, which prohibits cooperation with out-of-state investigations on transgender procedures and abortion services – were debated on the floor for more than 12 hours.

The Democrats, however, believe the majority they hold in the state is a mandate from voters to shield them from the Trump administration's policies, which recognize biological reality and protect children from dangerous and irreversible medical interventions.

# Democrats Called 'Insane' for Suing Trump Over Non-Citizen Voting

An executive order signed by President Donald Trump to ensure honesty at the ballot box has been hit by yet another lawsuit, this time for requiring proof you are a U.S. citizen before voting.

President Trump signed "Preserving and Protecting the Integrity of American Elections" in a March 25 ceremony at the White House. That E.O. has been hit with four lawsuits so far, including one filed recently by 19 Democrat-led states.

"The President has no power to do any of this," the state attorneys general complained in the court document. "The Elections EO is unconstitutional, antidemocratic, and un-American."

A White House spokesman called the proof-of-citizenship requirement "common sense" and called complaints from Democrats "insane."

In addition to the attorneys general, the March executive order has been challenged in court by the Democratic National Committee; State Democracy Defenders Fund; Campaign Legal Center; Democratic Governors Association; Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee; Democratic House Senatorial Campaign; U.S. Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer; and U.S. House Minority Leader Hakeem Jeffries.

While it is true election laws are set by state legislatures, it is also true many Republicans sincerely believe Democrats routinely cheat in elections and have no plan to stop doing so.

On the issue of citizen-only voting, Democrats have not helped their case with their permissive stance on illegal immigration, even going so far as refusing to ever use the term "illegal" publicly. Democrats have also passed laws to permit non-citizens to vote, such as city elections in Vermont

and Maryland, for example, and school board races in San Francisco and Oakland, California.

During the Biden administration, the wide-open U.S.-Mexico border was viewed by many Republicans as a welcome mat for 12 million future citizens, who could eventually win the right to vote in federal elections and reward those who let them stay.

The executive order signed by President Trump gives the Department of Homeland Security access to state voter rolls and allows DHS to remove illegally registered voters, and prosecute any of those who have actually voted.

Gary Bauer, of American Values, says the issue might be more complicated than Democrats simply want non-citizens to vote. Even though that is true, he says, the attorneys general would be "pretty stupid" to openly admit it in court documents.

"What they may be objecting to is that you have to show proof of identification to prove that you're a citizen," he says. "And they are willing to die on that hill."

Looking back at the Nov. 5 election, and Trump's overwhelming win, Bauer suspects the Democratic Party is desperate to avoid another loss like that in 2028.

#### Study: 'The View' is Aptly Named

While it's no surprise that the ABC talk show has had more liberal than conservative guests, the author of a recent study says the guest list is a reflection of how the cast is taking Trump's second term.

On most days, "The View" will invite guests to discuss current issues, usually politics. But the Media Research Center's (MRC) Nicholas Fondacaro says anyone who has been waiting for their favorite conservative pundit to debate with Whoopi, Joy, and the rest has been sorely disappointed.

"In the first three months of the year, they've had 63 guests come on to discuss politics in some way, shape, or form," he relays from his study. "Zero conservatives."

The fact that ABC News refuses to allow more than half the country to be represented, he says, is scandalous. "The View' ... does seem to ... only allow one view," Fondacaro observes. "The name is a directive."

He remembers that President Trump was often a welcomed guest before he ran for president. Now, however, the Trump Derangement Syndrome runs deep. "Ana Navarro said just the other day that she would prefer Biden in a coma over Trump," he notes.


Considering that is what the nation endured for the last four years, Fondacaro says, "It really comes down to the politics of it."

#### **Cornish Hens**

2 Cornish game hens (thawed) 1/2 – 1 stick butter (divided) 1/2 teaspoon salt 1/4 teaspoon pepper 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder



Mix seasoning in small bowl, divide in half and set aside.

Clean hens and pat dry. Place hens on a rack inside a foil lined pan with breast side up. Put 1 tablespoon butter and 1/2 seasoning inside each hen.

Melt remaining butter and stir in remaining seasoning. Brush over outside of hen and bake at 350° for one hour. Baste with butter throughout baking every 15-20 minutes. Skin should be crisp and golden. Juices run clear when meat is pierced.

#### Gina's Cabbage Soup

1/2 head of cabbage (chopped)

1 cup onion (chopped)

1 cup baby carrots (sliced)

1 cup celery (sliced)

8 oz. white button mushrooms (sliced)

2-3 cloves garlic (minced)

1 colored bell pepper (chopped)

1 can diced tomatoes

1 teaspoon basil

1/8 teaspoon black pepper

2 tablespoons olive oil

6 cups water

2+ tablespoons tomato/chicken bouillon crystals

Sauté onions, carrots, celery, mushrooms, garlic and bell pepper in olive oil until almost tender.

Add cabbage and canned tomatoes. Mix water and bouillon and add. (Adjust if it looks like you need additional water.) Bring to a boil; then reduce to medium heat until cabbage is tender.



#### **Cheese Grits**

1/2 cup grits

2 cups water (or 1 cup milk and 1 cup water)

Salt and pepper to taste

1/2 cup grated sharp cheddar cheese

2-4 tablespoons butter

Bring water to boil. Add seasoning. Whisk in grits over medium heat. Whisk for 5-7 minutes or until done and desired thickness. Stir in butter and grated cheese. Serve hot.

#### **Banana and Pear Cake**

1/2 stick of butter (softened)

1 cup sugar

1-2 well ripe bananas (mashed)

1 pear (peeled, cored and chopped)

2 eggs (beaten)

1 1/2 cups self-rising flour

1 teaspoon vanilla

Beat sugar and butter until creamy. Add eggs, vanilla, and flour. Beat until blended. Stir in fruit.

Pour into greased loaf pan and bake at 350° for 45 minutes. Insert toothpick to check for doneness.




